#### \*Typical Academic Supports

- Academic Advising
  - Scheduled sessions (weekly/monthly)
  - Oversee entire academic program
    - Support with dropping and adding a class
    - Support with course selection and registration
  - o Help students understand their strengths and weaknesses
  - Will help set short-term and long-term goals
  - Academic Advisors can serve as the primary contact person for parents or sponsors who have questions about the program
- Academic Growth
  - Determine student's goals
  - Studying & test-taking strategies
  - Reading Support
  - Writing Support
  - Executive Functioning
    - Planning
    - Time Management
    - Organization
- Academic Accommodations
  - Textbooks in alternate formats
  - Notetakers
  - Readers
  - Scribes
  - Testing accommodations
  - Use of adaptive equipment

### \*Typical Social Supports

- Transition into learning a new environment, making new friends and find their own community
- Structured living and learning environment that combines academics with social environments tailored to involving each student
- Early Orientation (Offered by some)
  - Move into campus earlier than other students to get acclimated with the campus and everyday life at the college without the rest of the student body being there
- Group Development
  - Group activities that engage students in the early orientation that help the student feel safe and welcome on campus

#### Social Activities

 Variety of different events to attract all ranges of students that promote friendship, relationship building and a safe environment to learn about oneself and others.

#### • Independent Living

- o Knowledge of campus environment
- o Knowledge of off-campus environment
- o Modes of transportation training
- Career Development
  - o Make time for career development and training
  - Career Coaches
  - Identifying Strengths
