### Logan Hugh Memorial Scholarship

**Due Date: 04/24/2024**

*Description: In memory of Logan Hugh Kammerer (the son of a former ELC teacher) this scholarship was created as a way to share love and hope with others. Established in June 2019 to recognize a student for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their school & community. Last year's winner received over \$4000.*

You must write a two page essay focusing on your ability to lead and serve as well as how you have made an impact on your school and/or community. You must include the name of your college and your major, why you decided to enter that field, your personal attributes that will help you to be successful in this major, what draws you to the field, any experience you've had in the field, and what you are most looking forward to accomplishing with your degree in that field.

### Leader of the PACK Scholarship

**Due Date: 05/02/2024**

**Description: Funds for scholarship: \$1,000.00 Scholarship**

**How the winner will be selected:** The school counseling department and administration will vote on personal statements.

#### **Requirements of prospective 12th grade students:**

1. Must be attending a 4-year college/university, community college, or technical school for the fall of 2024.
2. Must have at least an overall 3.5 GPA.
3. Must not have any disciplinary issues.
4. Must not have had more than 3 days unexcused absences or 5 unexcused tardies to school.

**Please provide a personal statement of no more than 300 words and answer the following questions:**

What strengths, skills or talents have helped you find academic success in high school? Name at least strength or skill you hope to grow as you move on with your post-secondary education.

Reflecting on your post-secondary education plans/major, what has influenced your decision to pursue this path?

What commitments or leadership roles have you undertaken in your high school? (these can be in or out of AGCS) Explain how these experiences have helped build your strengths or influenced your future plans.

What qualities make you the leader of the pack?

## E. Kneale Dockstader Foundation Scholarship

**Due Date: 04/26/2024**

**Description:** In honor of E. Kneale Dockstader's commitment to the communities of southern Chester County and to further his goals for environmental improvements in the community, the board of directors of the E. Kneale Dockstader Foundation has authorized scholarships in his honor.

Essay should be sent electronically to Mrs. Alaxson.

**School evaluation criteria:** The selection committee is to use the following criteria to make the selection of the Dockstader Scholarship recipient.

Requirement: Declaration of intent by the applicant to pursue a degree in environmental science or environmental engineering or related course of study.

33% Academics – This evaluation will include an analysis of grades and standardized test scores to establish a ranking of applicants.

33% Financial need – Schools will use their resources to determine the relative need of potential applicants with preference going to those most in need of support.

24% Good citizenship – Schools will rate applicants on in-school extracurricular activities and outside of school activities, with a predominant rating for in-school activities. (General letters of recommendation might be used here to augment the citizenship ranking process.

10% Essay – The applicant will complete a short essay (1 page) enumerating his/her interest in the environmental sciences and desire to further his/her education in this general field.

Description: Pennsylvania ASCD is committed to supporting preservice educators as they begin their teaching careers in the Commonwealth. Since 1994, PASCSD has been providing scholarship awards to students who are majoring in education at colleges and universities in Pennsylvania. Two scholarships are awarded annually.
