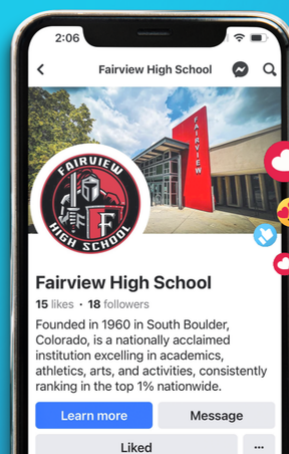

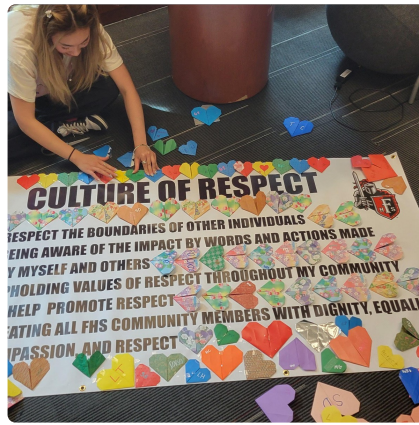
Building a Culture of Respect: Fairview High School's Initiative for Sexual Assault Awareness Month

Happy Springtime Knights! April is Alcohol Awareness Month, and it's crucial to address teen drinking, especially with Prom and Graduation approaching. Parents' attitudes play a significant role in shaping teen behavior, with about 80% feeling parents should have a say in their alcohol consumption. Binge drinking, defined as 4 or more drinks for females and 5 or more for males in about 2 hours, poses serious risks, including cognitive impairment and lifelong substance abuse issues. 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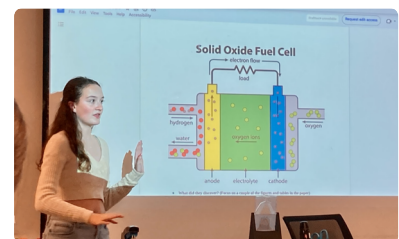
Experience Laughter and Chaos with Ken Ludwig's "Lend Me a Tenor"

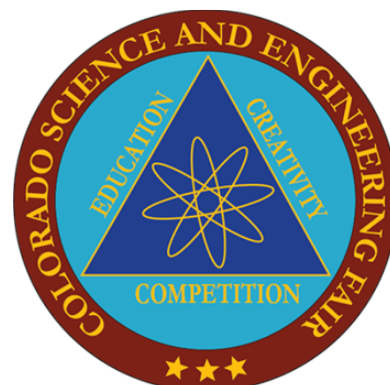

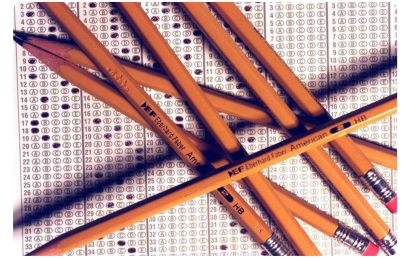

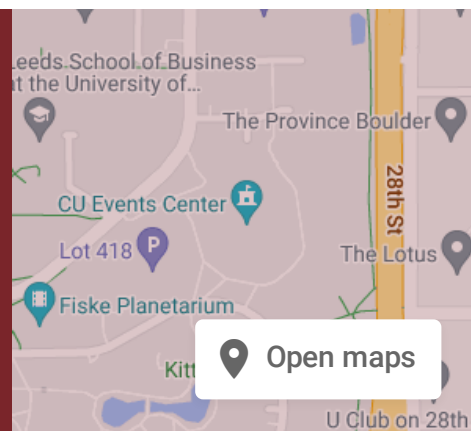
