Here is what parents need to know about Grit N' Wit:


*All HMS students who have a signed waiver will have an opportunity to go outdoors and participate in the physical challenges and mental puzzles.

SBAC 2024

Our students are ready to demonstrate their learning on the state assessments. Teachers have worked with students throughout the academic year to learn new concepts and skills aligned with the Common Core State Standards. The SBAC and NGSS assessments are aligned with these grade level standards. These assessments are important to students and parents because they are one indicator of a student's ability to understand content and apply grade level skills. The results help educators also understand how their students are performing in comparison to seventh and eighth graders across the state of Connecticut. This information is used to improve curricula and instruction at HMS. In short, these tests count!

Recently, teachers have engaged all students in individual conferences to discuss previous SBAC performance and to set goals for this year's assessment. We encourage our students to do their best, and we are determined to support them throughout this learning experience.

Our eighth grade students will begin testing on Monday, April 29th. They will complete four separate tests, including

- 1. NGSS (Next Generation Science Standards),
- Math CAT (Computer Adaptive Test).
- 3. Math Performance Task, and
- 4. ELA CAT.

Parents, you can support your children by ensuring they get proper rest. Consider setting a designated time to turn off technology each evening. Ensure your middle schooler eats a healthy breakfast and packs a water bottle and snacks. Most importantly, encourage your children to do their best. Positive words from their number one teachers make a difference

We will continue to keep our HMS community informed of testing schedules for both seventh and eighth grade students in future newsletters.
