(ELOP)
2023-2024**

What?

A free, after-school opportunity where grades TK-5 students can explore and engage through Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, & Math (STEAM). Physical education will be included as well. Some off-site experiences may be offered.

Why?

These experiences help to broaden students' academic skills and knowledge as well as the social and emotional capacity to use their skills and knowledge competently and compassionately in life.

When?

Immediately after each school day with an end time of 6:00 PM. (Minimum Days Included)

*End time of 5:00 PM at Crafton & Mission

Mentone, Franklin, Lugonia

Mission, Victoria, Crafton, Bryn Mawr,
Kingsbury

(Your child will participate at the school they attend.)

Attendance

Consistent attendance is most beneficial for students to gain the greatest benefit the program has to offer.

- Students are expected to report directly to the program immediately after dismissal of the school day.
- Students are encouraged to attend the entire length of the daily program.
- Early pick up is discouraged as it interrupts the flow of the activities planned for students.
- Refer to each specific school site for scheduled dismissal times as they vary.
- Students may not be picked up any later than 5:00 pm at Crafton & Mission, and no later than 6:00 PM at the remaining schools. If late, a "Late Pick-Up" notice will be issued. Any additional late pick-ups may result in dismissal from the program.

Behavior Expectations

- School Site Expectations are to be followed by students just as required during the regular school day. Please refer to the school expectations.
- Cell phones are prohibited from student use during the program, unless deemed necessary by staff.

Program Dismissal

Students may be dismissed from the program temporarily or permanently based on behavior or attendance issues. Staff will make every effort to support students and families with behaviors and attendance, but ultimately, student safety is our priority which may require dismissal from this program. This will be a site decision on a case-by-case basis.
