- **SENIOR CLASS MEETING:** Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup> in the auditorium during advisory.
- **SENIOR ORAL PRESENTATIONS:** Wednesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. When the schedule is posted, be sure to check for your assigned time.
- **SENIORS VS. STAFF SOFTBALL and BBQ:** Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> from 2:45 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- **SENIOR DEPARTMENT AWARDS:** Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at 12:45 p.m. in the RAL Auditorium. This is a social time for parents and seniors to visit with faculty and friends. Dress should be school appropriate.
- **SENIOR AWARDS ASSEMBLY:** Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup> – be there at 8:30 a.m. in the RAL Auditorium. Many community representatives will be presenting scholarships and awards to seniors, dress should be school appropriate. Parents are welcome to attend. .
- **SENIOR PROM:** Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup> from 9:00 p.m. to midnight at the Expo Center. All fines must be paid prior to purchasing a prom ticket.
- **THANK YOU NOTES:** Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 12:30 p.m. (5<sup>th</sup> period) in the Library. If you received a scholarship from the Senior Awards Assembly, please come and complete your thank you note that was in the envelope you were given. This time is set for seniors who received a scholarship at the Senior Awards Assembly, however, if you have received ANY scholarship funds from any organization, it is important to thank them for their generosity and you are welcome to attend. To write a thank you note shows respect and gratitude to all the people who make it possible for you to continue with your future goals. If you would like blank note cards and envelopes, there will be some available in the Guidance Office.
- **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:** All graduation requirements must be passed by noon on Wednesday, June 5<sup>th</sup> and all fines must be cleared or you will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- **SENIOR CHECK-OUT:** Wednesday, June 5<sup>th</sup> starting 6<sup>th</sup> period, you will be given a check-out sheet. Check-out will continue the next day, Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup> (periods 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>). Final clearance is 1:30 p.m. in the cafeteria.
- **BACCALAUREATE:** Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the RAL Auditorium. This is a religious service sponsored by the Longview Ministerial Association honoring the graduating seniors. Wear your gowns (but not your cap) and meet in the auditorium at 6:15 p.m. This is a formal affair.
- **GRAD WALK:** Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 a.m. Wear your cap and gown and meet in the Monticello parking lot.
- **COMMENCEMENT PRACTICE:** Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 p.m. at the Longview Memorial Stadium. **This practice is mandatory.**

- **COMMENCEMENT:** Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. at the Longview Memorial Stadium. Black or dark shoes are preferred. Be in the north stands by 9:30 a.m. The public will be seated in the stadium. Handicapped seating is available below the stadium. No tickets are needed.
- **DIPLOMAS: Pick up your actual diploma right after the graduation ceremony. Location: soccer room right behind the stadium near the back parking lot of Monticello Middle School**
- **FINAL TRANSCRIPTS:** During the week of June 24<sup>th</sup>, final transcripts will be forwarded to colleges/universities. To have your final transcript sent to your college/university, complete the google sheet during the Senior Class Meeting on April 19<sup>th</sup>
- **AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS:** Be sure you keep us posted on any scholarships you receive (even those you turn down). We like to recognize seniors who have received scholarships and will print these in the commencement program.
