COURSE OPTIONS & DESCRIPTIONS

All courses are virtual courses requiring access to the Internet and a device to play video and audio clips. Courses are asynchronous with optional live assistance. Book will be delivered via e-Book (Google Classroom, Google Docs, and Google Sheets). There will be no final exam. Students desiring to take more than one course should email dhandlogten@southlakechristianacademy.org prior for registration.

<p>1. IDA: INTRO TO DATA ANALYSIS <i>Teught by Nathan Simpson</i></p> <p><small>Required course for BC CA graduation - earns 0.5 math credit. C&G required. Required for the Senior Program. An understanding of averages, probability, and statistics. One will be able to use the normal distribution and graphs. A 100% of calculator is strongly recommended.</small></p>	<p>2. HEALTH <i>Teught by Kristin Lawford</i></p> <p><small>Required course for BC CA graduation - earns 0.5 credit. Students will examine personal and plans for living healthily. Through intensive activities and thought-provoking dialog, students focus on physical, mental, moral, social, government, and life skills while investigating the consequences of unhealthy habits.</small></p>
<p>3. BIBLICAL WISDOM LITERATURE <i>Teught by Jonathan Simpson</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 Bible elective credit. No prerequisites. Students will focus through the writing of Job, Proverbs, and the principles of wisdom from Proverbs, and the variety of the four Gospels. Students will engage in class reflection and personal Bible study centered around the question: What does it mean to be wise in God's eyes?</small></p>	<p>4. MUSIC APPRECIATION <i>Teught by Kristin Lawford</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 Fine Arts credit. No prerequisites. From the history and art of music through exposure to diverse styles of music from different time periods. Through discussion and music activities, students will begin to discover different styles of music and recognize their commonalities.</small></p>
<p>5. FOUNDATIONS OF ALGEBRA I <i>Teught by Jonathan Simpson</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 elective credit. No prerequisites. Foundations of Algebra I is comprehensive lesson designed to build solid foundation in algebraic concepts. Topics will include but are not limited to basic numbers, variables, equations, linear equations and quadratic equations. A solid foundation of mathematical reasoning provides a more robust success throughout other mathematical disciplines.</small></p>	<p>6. FOUNDATIONS OF ALGEBRA II <i>Teught by Jonathan Simpson</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 elective credit. Completion of Algebra I required. Foundations of Algebra II is an exciting course designed to build a student's understanding of algebraic concepts. This course builds upon previous material in Algebra I and includes a variety of topics including: solving systems of equations, functions, and trigonometry. This course is designed to help students develop a strong foundation in algebraic concepts and to prepare them for advanced mathematics.</small></p>
<p>7. CURRENT EVENTS <i>Teught by Danielle Handlogten</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 elective credit. No prerequisites. This course is designed to provide a comprehensive understanding of global and local current affairs. This course will focus on understanding and analyzing their impact on society, economics, and culture. Students will explore a wide range of topics from international relationships to environmental issues through a variety of media. Through interactive class discussions, and assignments, participants will develop their analytical skills and gain a deeper insight into the world's complex issues.</small></p>	<p>8. LEADERSHIP SEMINAR <i>Teught by Danielle Handlogten</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 elective credit. No prerequisites. This course will provide students with the opportunity to develop their leadership skills and capabilities. This seminar will explore various aspects of leadership, such as communication, decision-making, handling conflict, team management, and strategic thinking. Through a combination of experiential learning and practical exercises, participants will develop the essential skills needed to be an effective leader in their workplace.</small></p>
<p>9. CHRISTIAN MUSIC IN AMERICA <i>Teught by Jose Bai</i></p> <p><small>Covers some 0.5 Fine Arts credit. No prerequisites. Students will study the development of Christian music in the United States from the early days of hymns to modern worship rock and more. Students will analyze the lyrics and the musical structure of various styles of Christian music.</small></p>	<p><small>Students will identify SouthLake Christian Academy in the BC and BC-Career Center Office at their high school graduation. 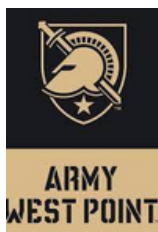

Spring Break 2025 - Scotland & Ireland

Rising freshmen - rising seniors will travel to Scotland and Ireland to explore the lands that were once home to ancient Celtic and Gaelic tribes. They will step into the Middle Ages on Edinburgh's Royal Mile and under the towering spire of St. Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin. While in Belfast, old conflicts have given way to an influx of restored 19th-century architecture and a thriving arts scene. A total of eight days will be spent exploring and expanding our knowledge of Scottish and Irish history and culture.

LEARN, SERVE, GROW 2025 SOUTHLAKE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY



The learn and serve week will take place **April 14-18, 2025 (*dates are subject to change)**. Make your plans now. Our goal at SouthLake Christian is to provide our upper school students with an education that is well-rounded and includes opportunities for learning.

Freshmen: During Learn and Serve Week, freshmen will engage in one day of campus-wide service, three days of enhanced learning classes, and one field trip.
