

Guidelines

- Students **MUST** receive written approval from their school counselor /district prior to enrolling in a course and paying tuition. This is typically through a failure letter sent to the home. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GRANTED. NO REFUNDS FOR FAILURE OF COURSE OR FAILURE TO COMPLETE THE COURSE IN THE SCHEDULED TERM.**
- Students must have access to a computer with Internet service that meets the specified technical requirements. **Computers ARE NOT provided for use.**
- Students must follow the Penn Hills School District's Acceptable Use and Academic Integrity policies. Failure to do so can result in removal from the program with no refund.
- Credit is awarded and recorded on the student's official transcript by the Penn Hills School district. The final percentage earned is reported from Waterfront Learning to the district.
- Students must adhere to course start/end dates. Extensions are available pending district approval AT the expense of student/parent. **NO REFUNDS will be given.**
- **IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Students are able to take **TWO** of the following courses (LIST) through the AIU . Students are **REQUIRED** to earn a passing grade (60%) or better in the course. A maximum of two courses can be taken for the summer.
- If not provided with the brochure, please refer to the Summer School FAQ's sheet on the Penn Hills School District website on the Linton Middle School page or Penn Hills High School Page.
- **Summer courses must be completed within the session's term. Waterfront Learning is unable to grant a pause or temporary stoppage of courses to accommodate vacations, camps, or other student activities.**

Question: Which course do I take?

Answer: First, confirm with your School Counselor which course you need, then enroll in the course that has Penn Hills in front of it.

BE SURE TO GET WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR: otherwise you will not be able to enroll. Written approval such as a failure letter is acceptable.

Also, when you register online for a course, a course, you have to choose a "school" in the Drop down menu under the Academic section. Choose "Waterfront." When it asks for your district, under school district information choose "Penn Hills". Recover Now courses are for students who have already taken a course during the school year and need to improve their performance. These are credit recovery courses, not for advancement.

Question: How many courses can I take?

Answer: You can take one course at a time but no more than two per summer.

Question: What if I am an NCAA athlete?

Answer: Make sure you indicate when you enroll that you are an NCAA athlete. **Recover Now courses are NOT NCAA approved.**

Question: How will my earned credit get transferred back to my school?

Answer. Waterfront Learning will report completed courses and grades to Penn Hills. The grade will then be added to your transcript.

Students have 4 weeks to complete the course and should commit no less than 15 hours a week to coursework.

Question: What if I have questions that cannot be answered by Waterfront Learning?
