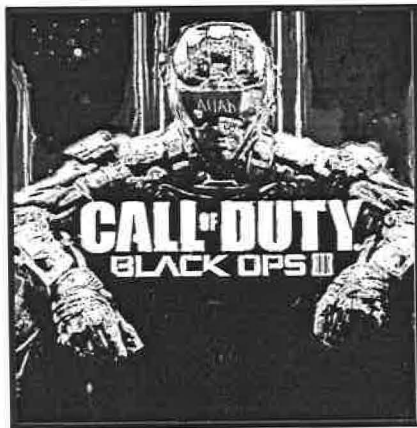

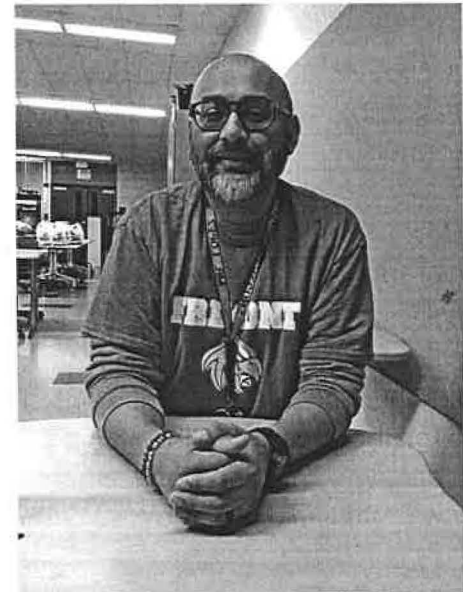

Summer Drought

In The Golden State, an extreme drought causes millions of people to conserve their water. The drought affects all of California (but mostly Southern California, which has the most population), causing all of the natives to cut back on water usage. The ones being affected the most are the farmers and farm workers. NASA is now predicting that our water supply is only enough for one more year! California is experiencing the worst drought in over 1,000 years, with only 4.4 million acres of water, it may seem like a lot to an



average person. Our reservoirs are only at 27% of their 100% capacity. One of the main sources for Southern California's water is the Colorado River, which is now at 40% of its capacity and which we share with Arizona, Nevada and mostly Mexico. Some of the water we get in Ventura County is from Lake Casitas in Ojai, but it's almost empty. Lake Casitas would usually hold 238,000 acre-feet of water but now only has 483.20 feet of water. Other places California gets its water from is Lake Mead and Lake Powell which, like Casitas, are low in water supply. The groundwater in Southern California is very low, so another way us Californians get our water supply is from groundwater which is imported from Northern and some parts of Central California. "DWR and the United States Geological Survey (USGS) estimates 140% of average precipitation is what's needed to actually get out of a drought. Sacramento Executive Airport, normal precipitation in a water year is about 18.14 inches". Since California is losing lots of water, we are also losing the ability to generate power to our homes. California uses the water pressure to generate power, and if there is no water then we can't use the water to get more power. The reasons why we are losing so much water are because of overpopulation, extreme heat, and lack of rain.

Things not to do during a drought:

Do not leave flowing water on... while brushing your teeth, washing utensils, washing your face, and do not use the hose for long use. Do not use water when not needed.

Things to do during a drought, make sure to...

Turn off water quickly after use, take short showers and use when only needed. Make sure to use water for a short period of time.

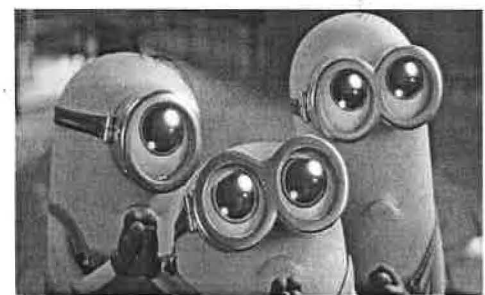
Best Movies to Watch in The Future

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When Fall Comes

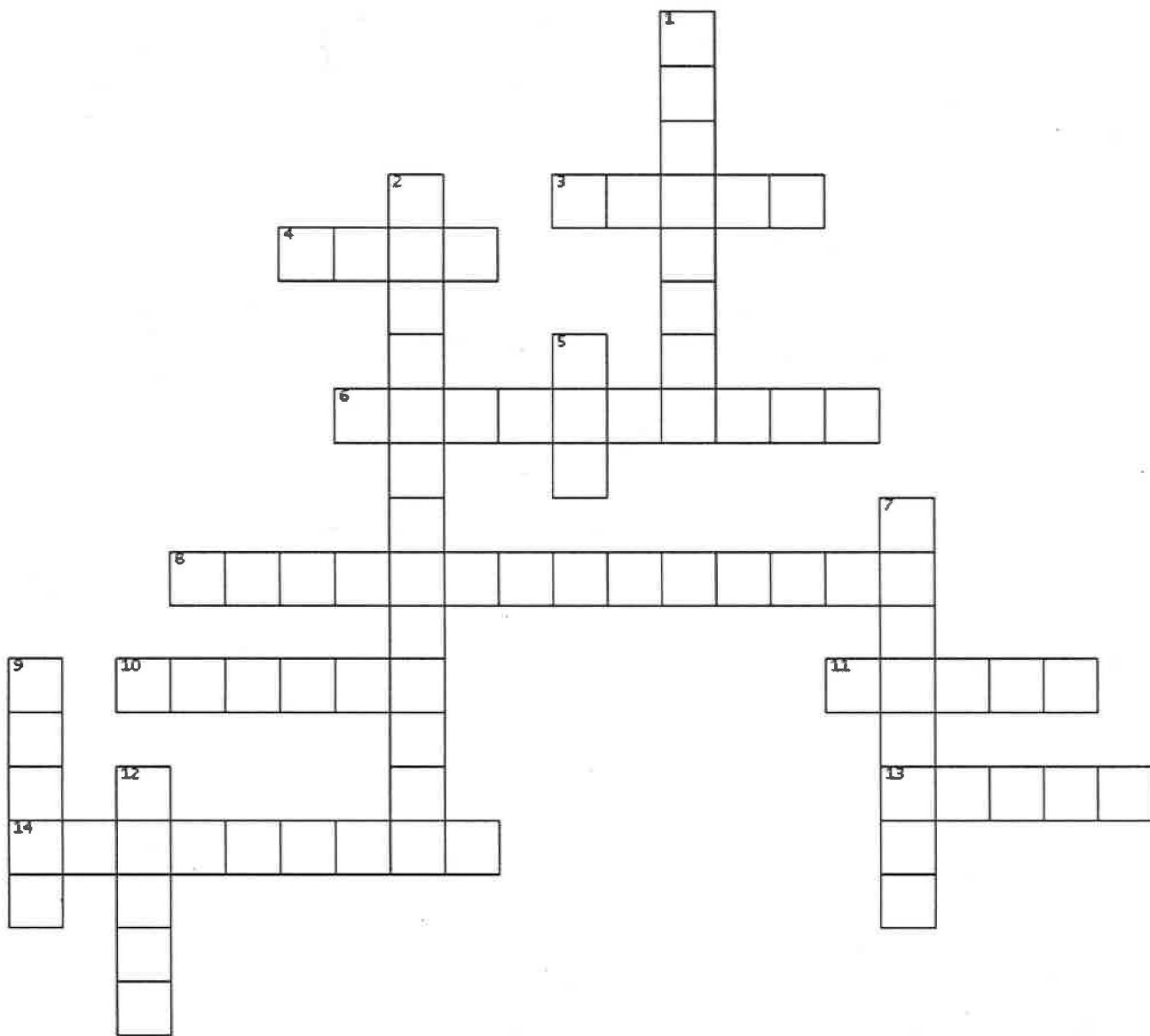
