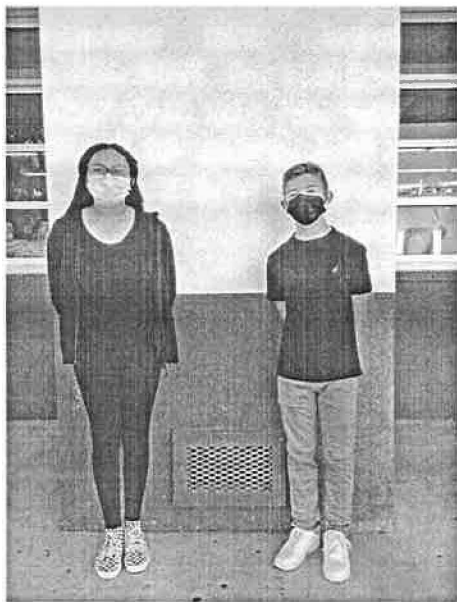

He was the number 32 and 33 while he played point guard for both the Los Angeles Lakers and for the Michigan State Spartans. Johnson was given the nickname "Magic" when he played on his Everett High School team by a sports writer who had just seen the 15-year-old prepster notch 36 points, 16 rebounds, and 16 assists. Johnson won his first championship back in 1980. He's won five championships overall in his basketball career.

Hurricane Ida hit the Gulf of Mexico on August 30th. During the storm more than 1 million people had to struggle with power outages and flooding. Heavy rain caused street's flooding, while the storm's winds and rain stretched



across more than 400 miles of the Gulf Coast from Louisiana to Florida. All of New Orleans and three cities were reported

without any power. Hurricanes are common storms that occur in the Atlantic Ocean, Gulf of Mexico and the eastern Pacific Ocean with wind speeds of at least 74 mph.

Ida was the most powerful hurricane to come across Louisiana ever. Hurricane Ida was not just deadly and destructive, it was the second-most damaging and intense hurricane to ever strike the U.S. It also hit other states like New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania on September 1st. Eleven deaths were reported to the Coroner's Office between August 30, 2021 and September 6, 2021.
