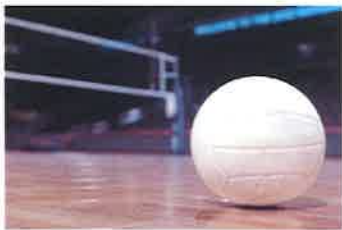

There is a new law that says that if a parent's kid were to cyberbully someone, the parents would have to pay about \$500. "A lot of parents refuse to believe that their son or daughter is bullying people," Burns said. "They want to believe that their kid is great and would not do such a thing." As a result, they never tell their child to stop. A 2011 survey of more than 24 million children ages 12 to 18 found that

nearly 28 percent of students reported being bullied. That is about 6.8 million kids. They were called names, insulted, threatened with harm and pushed or shoved. Nine percent, or about 2.2 million kids, said they were cyberbullied. The article states "Bullying can have terrible consequences." Bullied kids often start to feel bad about themselves. Some are afraid to go to school. In the worst cases, bullied kids have killed themselves or other students. This is why the new law has been set.

The Discovery Of Homo Naledi

From October 2013 through July 2022, a new species of hominin, a primate species closely related to humans, was discovered and named Homo Naledi. Remains were found in the Rising Star Cave system in South Africa in the Dinaledi Chamber and the nearby Lesedi Chamber.



In the Dinaledi Chamber they found 1550 specimens, and in the Lesedi chamber they found an additional 133 specimens.

Researchers have claimed Homo Naledi had human-like hands as well as a brain smaller than humans. The fossils were

dated to between 335,000 and 236,000 years ago.

Researchers came to the conclusion that Homo Naledi buried its dead. The Homo Naledi is the first known non-human species to bury and mark their dead's graves. There have been carvings and symbols found on the walls above the buried to mark those who were laid to rest there. The symbols were similar to hashtags, triangles, and squares. The human brain is three times as big compared to Homo Naledi; therefore, it's a surprise to know they practiced ritual burials, something that was assumed to be only done by humans. Along with burying their dead, the researchers believe Homo Naledi also used fire.

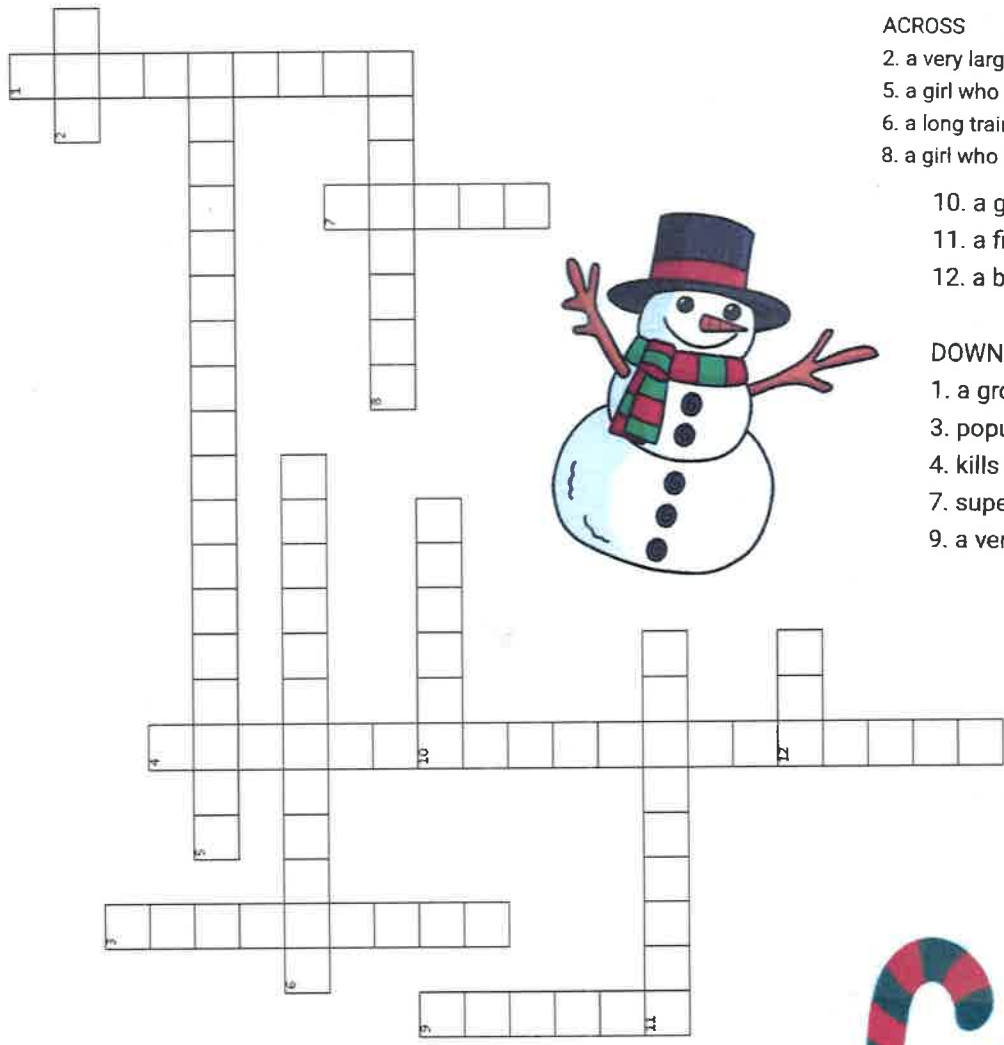
