# Did you know?



**Across the United States, almost 25 million students are waiting for afterschool care ...**

- For every child in an afterschool program, three are waiting for a program

**Kids from families with economic uncertainty are more likely to miss out ...**

- Families in the highest income bracket spend five times more on afterschool activities

**Today, more families are struggling to afford and find an afterschool program ...**

- Parents report barriers to participation include cost and lack of programs/space

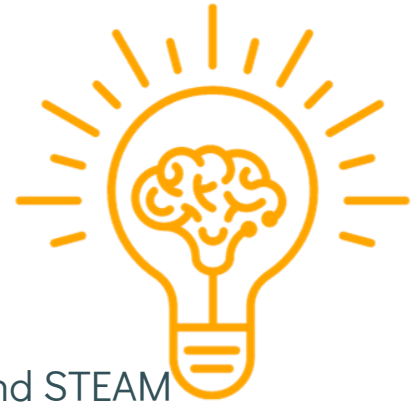
# Afterschool Programs can ...

## Help kids accelerate learning and restore well-being

- Interacting with peers and building social skills
- Taking part in physical activities
- Building life skills
- Engaging in activities that encourage growth, like VAPA and STEAM

## Support parents/guardians with providing for their families

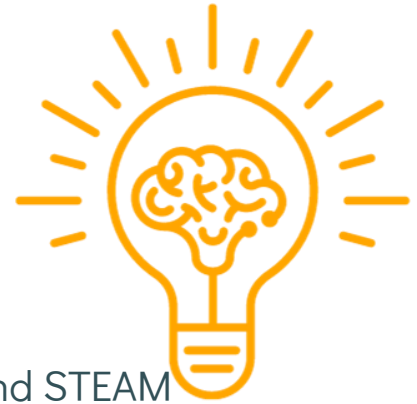
- Helping working families keep their jobs

# OVSD Afterschool ELOP Planning & Implementation Timeline

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August 2022	OVSD Afterschool ELOP presented to Board of Trustees for information and input
Fall 2022	OVSD Afterschool ELOP Pilot implemented at Oak View and Westmont
Late Fall 2022	OVSD Afterschool ELOP Pilot implementation update presented to Board of Trustees
Early 2023	OVSD Afterschool ELOP plan presented to Board of Trustees for review and approval, the plan will then be posted on the OVSD website
Summer 2023	OVSD Afterschool ELOP Plan full implementation



# ELOP Program Purpose

The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program focuses on developing the **academic, social, emotional, & physical needs** of **unduplicated pupils\*** through:

- Extending Instructional Learning Time
- Accelerating Learning
- Integrating Student Supports
- Supporting Staff Professional Development



**Unduplicated Pupils** are any students that qualify for one or more programs, including: Free & Reduced Lunch, Foster Youth, & English Learner.

# ELOP Program Requirements

ELOP **increases the achievement of unduplicated pupils** by providing access to comprehensive **afterschool & intersessional** learning opportunities



## Academic School Year

- **9 hour day with wrap-around services**
  - instructional day + afterschool services
- 180 days of service
- **In OVSD, afterschool only**

## Intersessional Days

- **9 hour day**
  - Instructional time + after instruction services
- 30 additional days of service
  - Summer, Thanksgiving, Winter, or Spring Breaks
- **In OVSD, may be combined with the Summer Education Academy (SEA)**

# ELOP Participation Requirements

LEAs with unduplicated pupil population (UPP) below 80% must:

## OFFER

ALL Grade TK-6 UPP students in the entire LEA

## ACCESS

Provide program for 50% of Grade TK-6 UPP

## ATTENDANCE

Based on needs of the student and family  
(funding is not tied to attendance)

## Projected Numbers for OVSD

- Unduplicated Pupil Population: **2,316 students**
- 50% Enrollment Target: **1,558 students**





# Next Steps



- Develop an understanding of ELOP components and redesign of the afterschool Kids' Club program to meet the ELOP requirements. (In OVSD, before-school child care is only available at a cost and is not part of ELOP.)
- Align existing staff, hire new staff, and contract staff as needed.

## PILOT - - Afterschool ELOP

### Westmont

- Open Kids' Club ELOP with contracted staff

### Oak View

- Contract additional spaces for students with existing partners

## **BUILD** - - Afterschool ELOP

### Kids' Club

- Add TK-5th Afterschool ELOP within existing Kids' Clubs one at a time (expansion based on UPP)

## **Provide Update to the Board of Trustees**



# Next Steps



## Grade 6 Expansion

- Provide 6th grade Afterschool ELOP at Oak & Mesa

## **DRAFT** - - Afterschool ELOP Plan

### Continue Engagement with Educational Partners

- Students, parents, OVSD staff & District leadership

### Draft Proposal

- Based on partner feedback, create draft Afterschool ELOP Plan

**Board APPROVAL** - - Afterschool ELOP Plan  
Post the Afterschool ELOP Plan on the District website

**FULL IMPLEMENTATION** - - Afterschool ELOP

- Fully implement the Afterschool ELOP plan beginning July 1, 2023
