## FULL In-Person Reopening Update

- All students are attending classes on campus 5 days per week.
- Adherence to COVID-19 layers of protection/mitigation has resulted in continued safety for our students and staff.
- OVSD currently has just one positive COVID-19 case among students and staff.



# Safety Protocols

- Relax one of our safety protocols in alignment with CDPH guidance:
  - Health/Temperature Screening Revisions
- Continue other COVID-19 layers of protection/mitigation for the safety of our students and staff.



# At Home Health/Temperature Screening

- Student and staff health/temperature screenings will no longer be required when entering the school grounds.
- Staff will continue self-screening at home as required in the collective bargaining agreements and the COVID-19 Prevention Program.

## Home Health Screening

Each morning before coming to school, use the following protocol: (If you answer YES to any one of the questions below, do not bring your child to school)

- Is your child currently experiencing any new or unexpected COVID-19 related symptoms?
  - Fever >100.4F or feeling feverish (chills, sweating)
  - New cough
  - Difficulty breathing
  - Sore throat
  - Muscle aches or body aches
  - Vomiting or diarrhea
  - New loss of taste or smell
- Is anyone in your household presenting new or unexpected COVID-19 related symptoms?
- Have you recently had close contact (more than 15 minutes within six feet) with someone who is ill, presenting COVID-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19?



# Mask Wearing Reminders

- Students, staff, and parents must wear a mask when arriving and exiting school grounds, inclusive of the parking lots; the boundaries will be the sidewalks surrounding the schools.
- Students, staff, and visitors continue to wear masks while inside or outside on school grounds, regardless of social distancing or vaccination status.
- Masks are removed for eating and drinking. Teachers continue to provide mask breaks, as needed.





## Next Steps

- Provide communication to families regarding the change to only home health/temperature screening and announce the transition date of May 17.
- Continue to monitor and reinforce the importance of respecting our COVID-19 protocols to ensure the continued health and safety of our students and staff.
- Continue to monitor state directives for school reopening Fall 2021.
