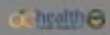


Tier Framework Metrics

County Risk Level*	Daily New Cases (per 100k)** (7-day average w/ 7-day lag)	Positive Tests (7-day average w/ 7-day lag)	Health Equity Quartile (7-day average w/ 7-day lag)
WIDESPREAD Tier 1	>7 new daily cases (per 100k)	>8%	
SUBSTANTIAL Tier 2	4 - 7 new daily cases (per 100k)	5 - 8%	5.3 - 8%
MODERATE Tier 3	1 - 3.9 new daily cases (per 100k)	2 - 4.9%	2.2 - 5.2%
MINIMAL Tier 4	<1 new daily cases (per 100k)	<2%	<2.2%

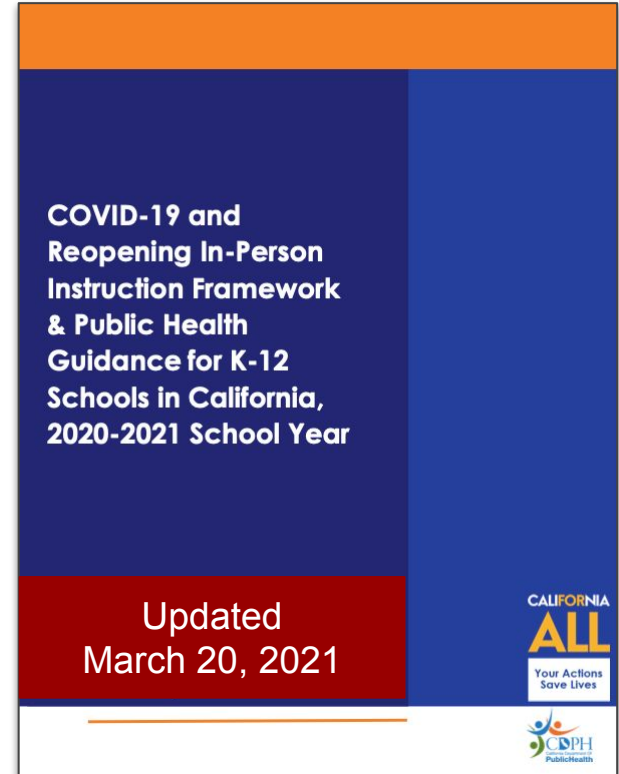

UPDATED California School Reopening Guidance

- California Department of Public Health (CDPH) recent guidance for schools reduced social distancing between students in classrooms to a minimum of 3 feet.
- Layering of mitigation strategies decreases the risk of in-school transmission.
- Masks: Students and staff with medical exemptions must wear a shield with a drape.

In-Person Phase 3 Reopening Transition Impact

- Families of students who will have a new teacher will be contacted by their school's principal.
- We suggest that you begin preparing your child for this change.
- Opportunities for students to learn new routines and meet new friends.
- School-based social emotional support for students' transition.



Next Steps

- Provide communication to all OVSD families regarding the transition.
- Communicate and reinforce COVID-19 layers of protection/mitigation to ensure continued safety of our students and staff.
- Continue to facilitate vaccination opportunities for staff.
- Continue to explore ways to increase teacher-directed instructional time for Middle School students.
- Continue to monitor state directives for school reopening Fall, 2021.
