- Our overarching goal is keep students in school while balancing the wellness and safety of our entire community



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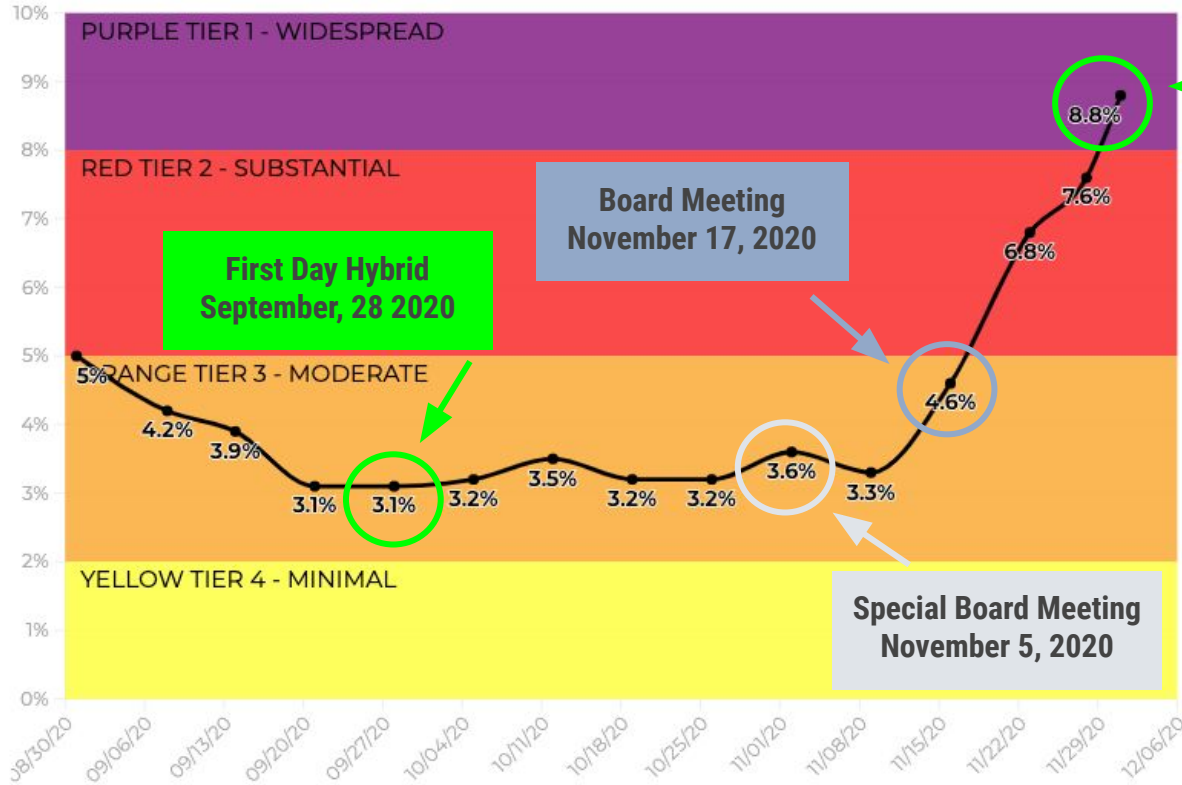
COVID-19 Risk **Orange County**

November 15 - Current: Tier 3/**Purple – Widespread**



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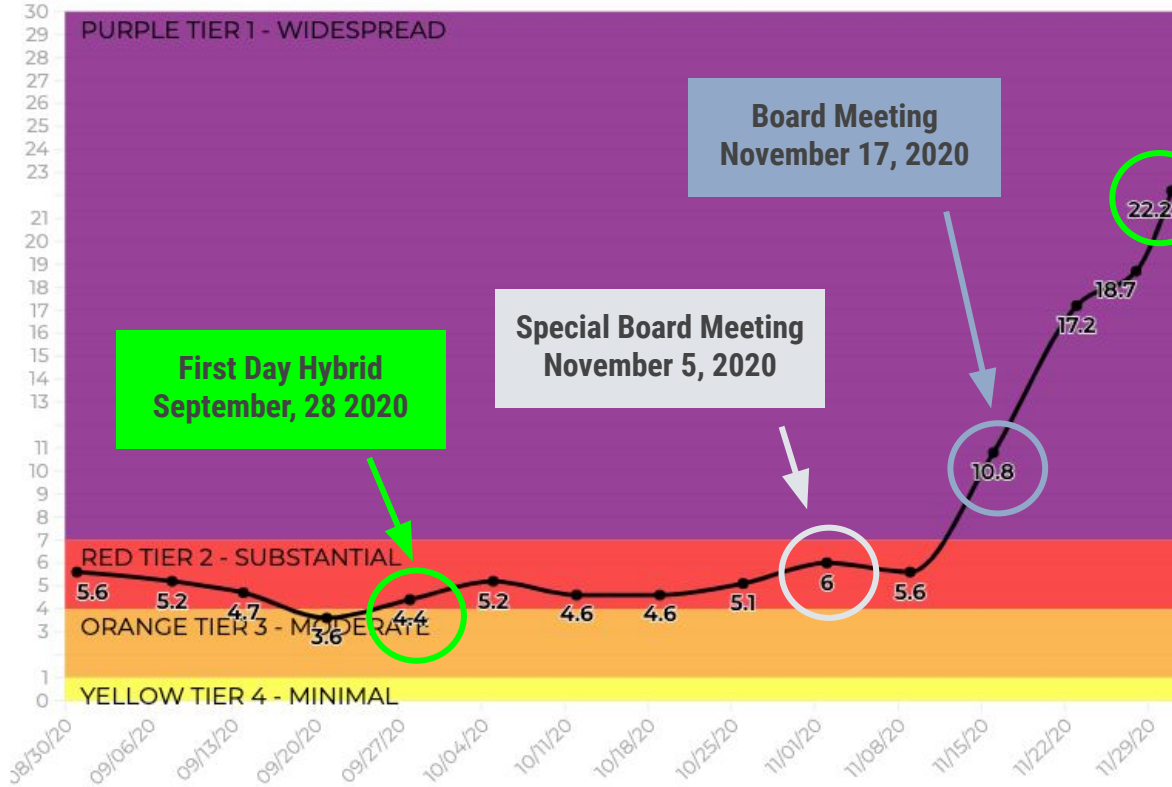

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Enhanced Split Week Schedule Recommendations

- Enhance current split week schedule to provide more time in school and more direct instruction via Zoom
- Limit disruption to family schedules, same days at school
- Lengthen school day for more socialization and instruction
- Slight modification to school start and end times
- Increase structured instruction while students are at home via Zoom

- Continue to monitor COVID-19 in our community and positivity rates in Orange County and OVSD
- Continue to explore enhanced hybrid schedule with bargaining units
- Make adjustments to staff assignments
- Provide updates at future Board Meetings
