Feasibility of making modifications to existing hybrid schedule



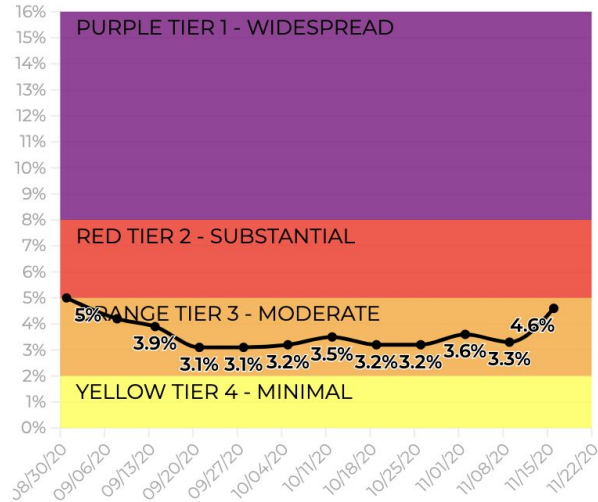

COVID-19 Statistics

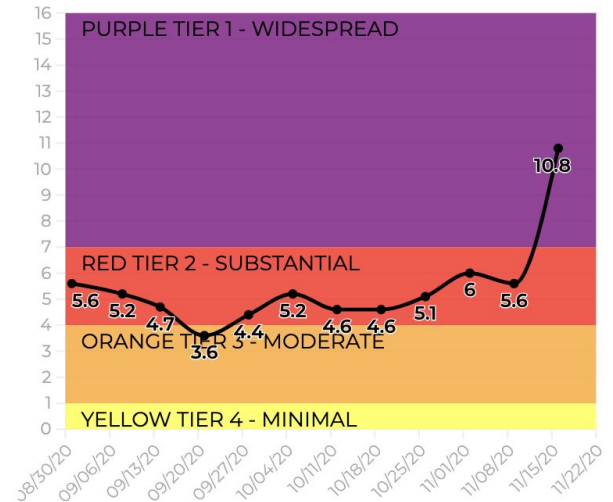
