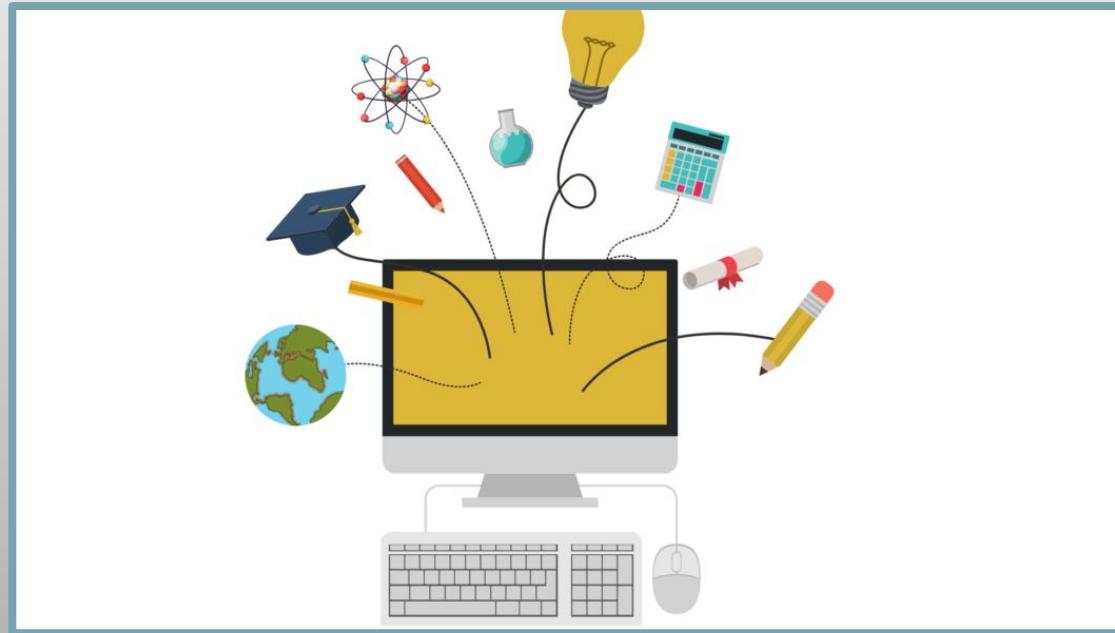

California Department of Education Definition

'Distance Learning' means instruction in which the student and instructor are in different locations.

This may include:

- *Interacting* through the use of a computer and/or communication technology
- *Delivering instruction*
- Face-to-face check-in time between students-teacher
- Video or audio instruction in which the primary mode of *communication between the student and instructor is online*
- The *use of print materials* incorporating assignments that are the subject of written and/or oral feedback

CDE Required Components	OVSD Structure	Purpose & Function
1) Learning Platform	Clever	Teachers & Students go to “school” daily via Clever www.ovsd.org/go
2) Learning Management System/Communication Structure	Google Classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teachers post daily agenda or assignments• Students visit “classroom” to find the day’s work
3) Presentation Tools	Google Meet YouTube Creator Zoom	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Live teaching sessions that students can join and/or• Ability to record sessions/lessons to be posted for students to access at a later time• Office hours to support students & parents - “live” office hours are optional
4) Lesson Content	Teacher Autonomy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• OVSD-supported apps (ConnectEd, ST Math, etc)• Site-supported apps (Benchmark, MobyMax, etc)• Outside teacher selected resources (Class Dojo, etc)

Clever is an online platform used to provide students access to all of OVSD's digital programs in one place. Students can access their district-supported learning applications by logging into the OVSD Clever Portal.

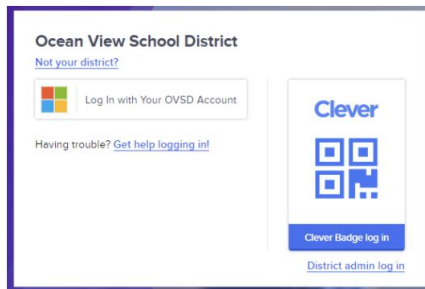

Enrichment	30-40	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Balance of science, social studies, PE, & SEL lesson, video, and/or an assignment/activity
PE/Movement	20	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lesson, video, and/or an assignment/activity
Teacher Office Hours	30	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consistent time TBD by teacher

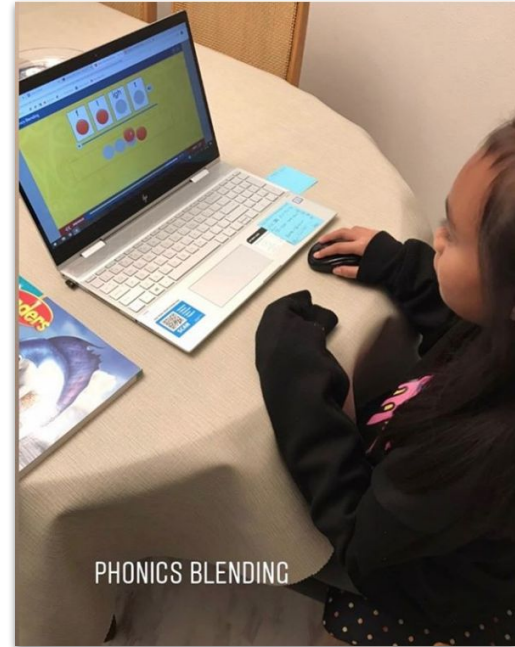
Etiquette/Management for Distance Learning

3. Create a daily to-do list, checking off items as completed
4. Avoid distractions

9. Decompress at the end of the day
