Vista View Student Presentation

Five Vista View 6th graders, led by Principal Dr. Gates and teacher Mrs. Cho, provided the Board with a presentation on the GATE standards of origin and impact. The students shared interesting and fun games they created to help their classmates learn more easily about cells and life.

Mid-Year LCAP Update

Dr. Julianne Hoefer, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, provided the Board with an update on the Local Control & Accountability Plan (LCAP) with mid-year data for the metrics and expenditures identified in the plan. When OVSD adopted the 2021-22 LCAP and Budget, the state budget act was not complete. The adopted state budget included additional funds of \$491,529 that were not anticipated. OVSD used the funds to reduce class size and increase the number of staff who provide direct services to students. The Supplement for the annual update included Educational Partner Engagement for Budget Act funds, use of additional concentration funding, Educational Partner Engagement for one-time federal funds, implementation of the ESSER III Expenditure Plan, and using fiscal resources consistent with LCAP.
