i-Ready Assessment

i-Ready Assessment is given three times a year and identifies which students are experiencing difficulties with specific skills, providing real-time, actionable data and reports to guide teachers in effective intervention. It breaks down student results into three instructional levels:

Core - student is at/above grade level

Strategic - student is slightly below grade level

Intensive - student is below grade level

In the Spring 2021 Language Arts Assessment, 60% of OVSD students scored at Core, 22% at Strategic and 18% at Intensive. In Math, 54% of OVSD students scored at Core, 30% at Strategic and 16% at Intensive. The District held a Summer Learning Acceleration Program (SLAP) to mainly help students who were scoring in the Strategic and Intensive levels. At the conclusion of the SLAP program, student scores rose dramatically, especially among English Learners and students with special needs. [See presentation here.](#)

Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Expenditure Plan

Dr. Julianne Hoefler, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, provided the Board with updated budgetary information related to ESSER funding, and the Board approved the proposed expenditure plan. The three main areas that will be targeted with the funds are addressing the impact of lost instructional time, strategies for continuous and safe in-person learning, and improvements to heating, ventilation, air conditioning.
