Transportation Update

Dr. Carol Hansen, Superintendent, provided the Board with a transportation update. OVSD suspended busing, largely due to COVID, in 2020. In addition, the District has had a transportation encroachment on our general fund of as much as \$2.2 million per year. After listening to parents speak about the need for busing, the Board provided direction to implement fees of \$600 per year for bus transportation for students in high interest areas. The Board will subsidize the remainder of the costs this year, and they will review fees annually.

Bus routes will be determined by the District's ability to secure drivers and reach a minimum number of students required. There is currently a national shortage of bus drivers, but we are exploring a number of options in order to fill the positions needed. [See the presentation here.](#)
