Marine View Art Presentation

Marine View Principal Sara Schaible highlighted the visual arts program at Marine View, led by teacher Andrew Estrada. She explained how the Art Program is designed to provide students with an introduction to fundamental art concepts, while providing an opportunity for them to explore the creative process through various projects and applications. Mrs. Schaible referenced the tall boards of student art projects surrounding the Board Room that reflect appropriate tool usage, shading techniques, defining light and shadow, color theory, form, and perspective. A poster composed of individual student's art tiles compiled together to form a picture was showcased. Kelly Heinrich and Chloe Heddle, both students in Mr. Estrada's art class, explained how their art elective class has impacted them, providing a safe and nurturing environment that allows them to express themselves and explore new interests.
