Hope View Principal Christy Luckey highlighted their “School Happenings” Bulletin Board that depicts systems they have in place to ensure that students feel welcomed, heard, and ready to learn. Special education teacher Kristie Krattiger spoke about the special Coffee Cart project that she established for her students. They do typical things like grind beans and brew coffee, but they also work on important life skills. Their coffee cart jobs provide hands-on experience with communication, sequencing steps, reading, hygiene, and math/money skills. Another great benefit of the Coffee Cart is the opportunity for inclusion. The special education students have a buddy system with general education students who help them when taking orders and delivering coffee to staff. They work together building relationships, life skills, and making connections.

Marine View Principal Sara Schaible was joined by teacher Tracy Souders, and students Sophie, Reagan, Katelyn, and Priscilla. While brainstorming ideas for a project related to student voice, Principal Schaible and Mrs. Souders came up with the idea of students creating soapbox speeches. Mrs. Souders provided students with various topics to choose from, such as: pressure to get good grades, bullying, homework, dress code, vaping, and student choice in activities. Sophie spoke about the history of soapbox speeches, Reagan and Katelyn read their soapbox speeches, and Priscilla let the Board know what Marine View is doing to help students manage stress and address bullying.
