1. 6:05 p.m. Circle View Elementary School: Bulletin Board Presentation

Circle View Principal Jessica Haag shared information about two math programs utilized at Circle View: iReady Math and ST Math. Teacher Meghan Balsillie commented on her student's work with i-Ready Math, while teacher Janeen Autry spoke about the benefits of ST Math. 3. 6:25 p.m. Superintendent's Schools Task Force Update

Dr. Joe Farley, facilitator of the Superintendent's Schools Task Force, provided the Board with an update on the first Task Force meeting held on April 26, 2023. In the upcoming meetings, the Task Force will discuss a variety of pertinent topics, including demographics, legal requirements, Measure R history/modernization, boundary adjustments, school funding, enrollment decline, and the instructional impact of smaller schools. He noted that the next Task Force Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 10, 2023.

J. Public Comment

Robert Espinoza, parent, thanked the Board for approving the Park View project that resulted in a park and parking lot for the community; expressed appreciation for the new HVAC system at Circle View; reminded everyone about the positives of Ocean View School District when considering placement of their children in schools.

John Briscoe, community member, stated his opposition to the censure resolution on tonight's agenda, written by Norm Westwell against Patricia Singer; suggested this action might jeopardize the future of Mr. Westwell's political career.

President Singer noted that she provided welcoming comments at the Superintendent's Schools Task Force first meeting and, out of respect for the process, she left so as not to influence the Task Force; attended Hope View's Open House and participated in their Coffee Cart activity; attended the Dual Language Immersion event at Harbour View; is looking forward to celebrating our staff during "Week of the Employee" next week.

5. Superintendent's Communications

Dr. Conroy shared that this past weekend, he met a parent, Gersain Pluma, who spoke highly of the District and is grateful his three children attend our schools. He also spoke with a former Ocean View Student, Alex Worthy, who is a Senior Legal Services Attorney for the California School Boards Association. Alex shared how much she appreciated her experience in the District.

Sarah Bruce, School Office Clerk at College View, volunteered her time to support students in the *Kids Run the OC* program this past Saturday, as she has done in previous years. Sarah always serves our parents and students with a positive attitude, making important connections. Also at College View, the staff is truly grateful for their new school librarian, Mrs. Mehr. She has organized and labeled the library to facilitate easier book access for students. Additionally, she has opened the library during recess times for students to enjoy.

Instructional Aide Danielle Kesler has been working in Special Education for 15 years and accompanies her students who participate in the Visual and Performing

Arts (VAPA) Program. Her goal is to help each student reach their full potential and is proud when Special Day Class (SDC) students are mainstreamed into general education programs and activities.

Special thanks to Information Technology Director Rick Larson and his team who recently supported Star View's parent education night, focusing on state testing readiness. They provided laptops, ensured there were no connectivity issues, and had technical support on hand at the event.

Congratulations to Reagan Headrick, Tim Golden, Elaine Burney, Jenna Landero, Sara Schaible, Jadyun Grunbaum, Simi Sardana, Kim Slack, and Jim Riner for successfully completing the 2022-23 School District Negotiators Certification Program through the School Employers Association of California (SEAC) organization.

Stephanie Christidis' 4th grade class at Oak View is striving to reach their goal of 90% of their class achieving 100% in ST Math, and they are well on their way with 18 students already meeting that benchmark. Also at Oak View, Community Liaison Jadira Lopez facilitated her first successful Cinco de Mayo event, under the mentorship of former Community Liaison Sherry Medrano, who recently retired. This wonderful event promotes the school's strong community connections.

The District's GATE Teacher Certification Cohort #3 earned their Countywide GATE certification and were celebrated at our Scholar's Showcase on April 25. Dr. Conroy stated that after careful review, it would not be an efficient use of the District's financial resources to merge Mesa View and Spring View Middle Schools next year. Mesa View will be moving to the Interim Site as planned for the 2023-24 school year while their site is being modernized.

He reported on the first Superintendent's Schools Task Force meeting, where parents, community members, and staff shared their initial thoughts and highlighted issues to discuss further. The Task Force will meet again on May 10, 2023, with the agenda including information on budget, staffing, and educational impacts due to enrollment.


