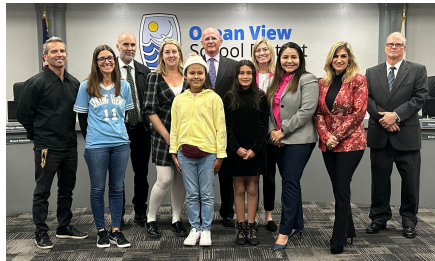

Middle School Attendance Boundary Map

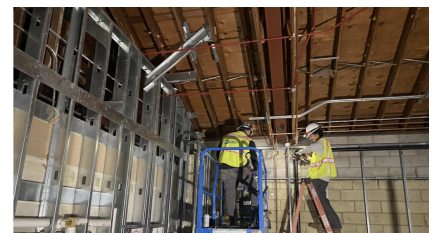

Resolution - Establishing Trustee Areas and Elections By-Trustee Areas

The Board of Trustees passed the resolution for Ocean View School District to initiate the process of establishing trustee areas and elections by trustee areas, to take effect with the 2026 election.
