Middle School Boundary Changes

With the closure of Spring View Middle School effective at the end of the 2023-24 school year, the District needs to redraw the middle school attendance boundaries for the 2024-25 school year. Superintendent Dr. Michael Conroy delivered a progress report on the middle school boundary timeline, along with presenting various boundary options, following the initial round of elementary community meetings held before winter recess. Substitute Teacher Pay Rate Increase

Ocean View School District is committed to developing and maintaining a pool of qualified substitute teachers in order to fill all certificated absences consistently. The Board approved a permanent increase in the daily rate of pay for substitute teacher positions from \$150 to \$200 and the long-term daily rate of pay from \$180 to \$225. Additionally, the daily rate of pay for long-term substitute teachers in special education positions was raised to \$235, if they hold the appropriate credentials. Expanding the dates for the current special substitute rate for designated District professional development days of \$250 to include District identified hard to fill days, was previously approved.
