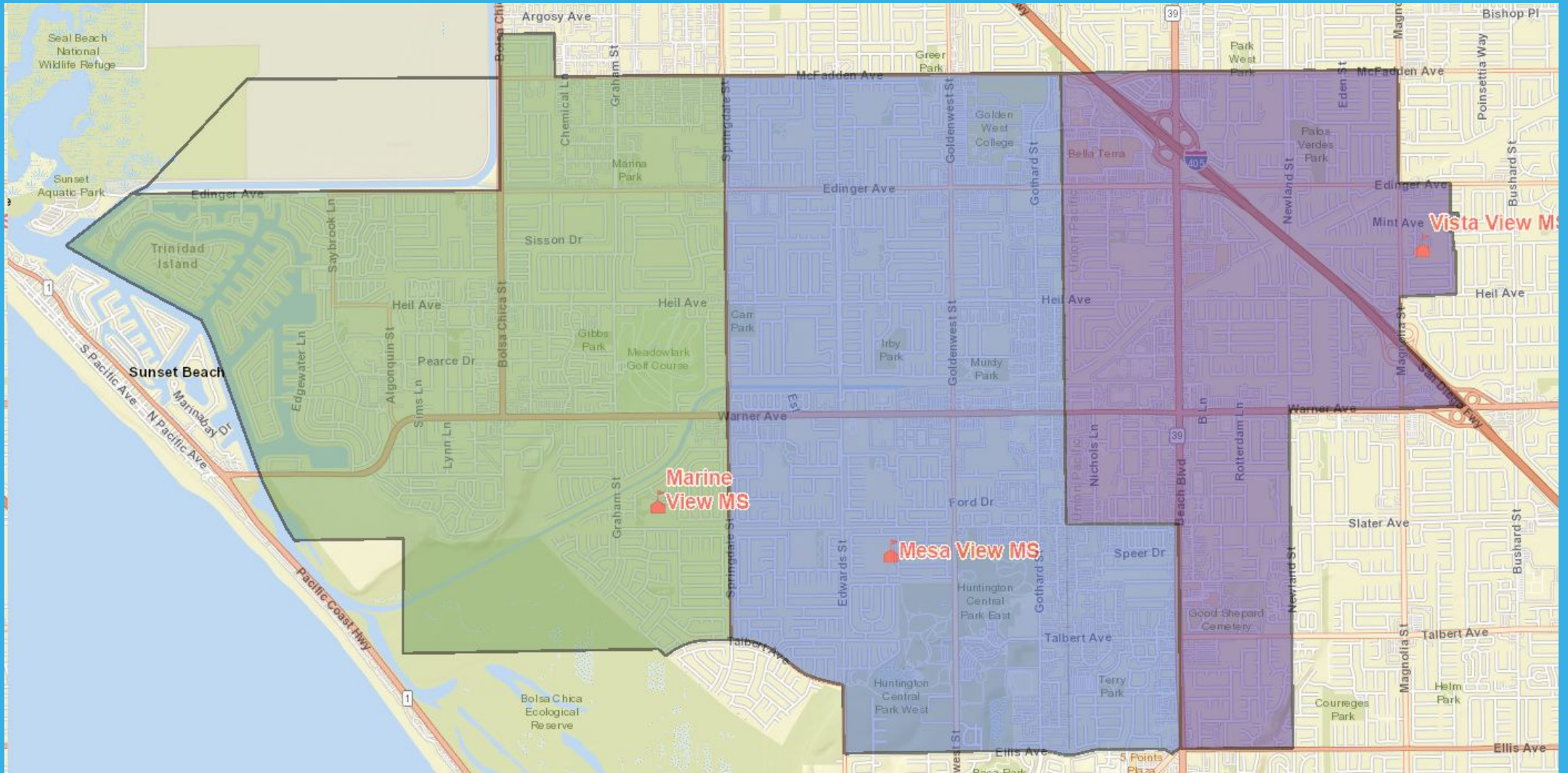


CURRENT TRANSPORTATION PRACTICES

- Transportation of Special Education students is through an IEP
- Families must submit a Transportation Application
- Transportation for unduplicated families is provided
- No transportation provided for **intradistrict** transfers, **interdistrict** transfers, and GATE Magnet placements
- After school late bus service continues at middle schools
- Field trips are site determined and site funded
- Oak Community to Vista Middle School services will continue
- Modernization transportation services will cease after the completion of Mesa View

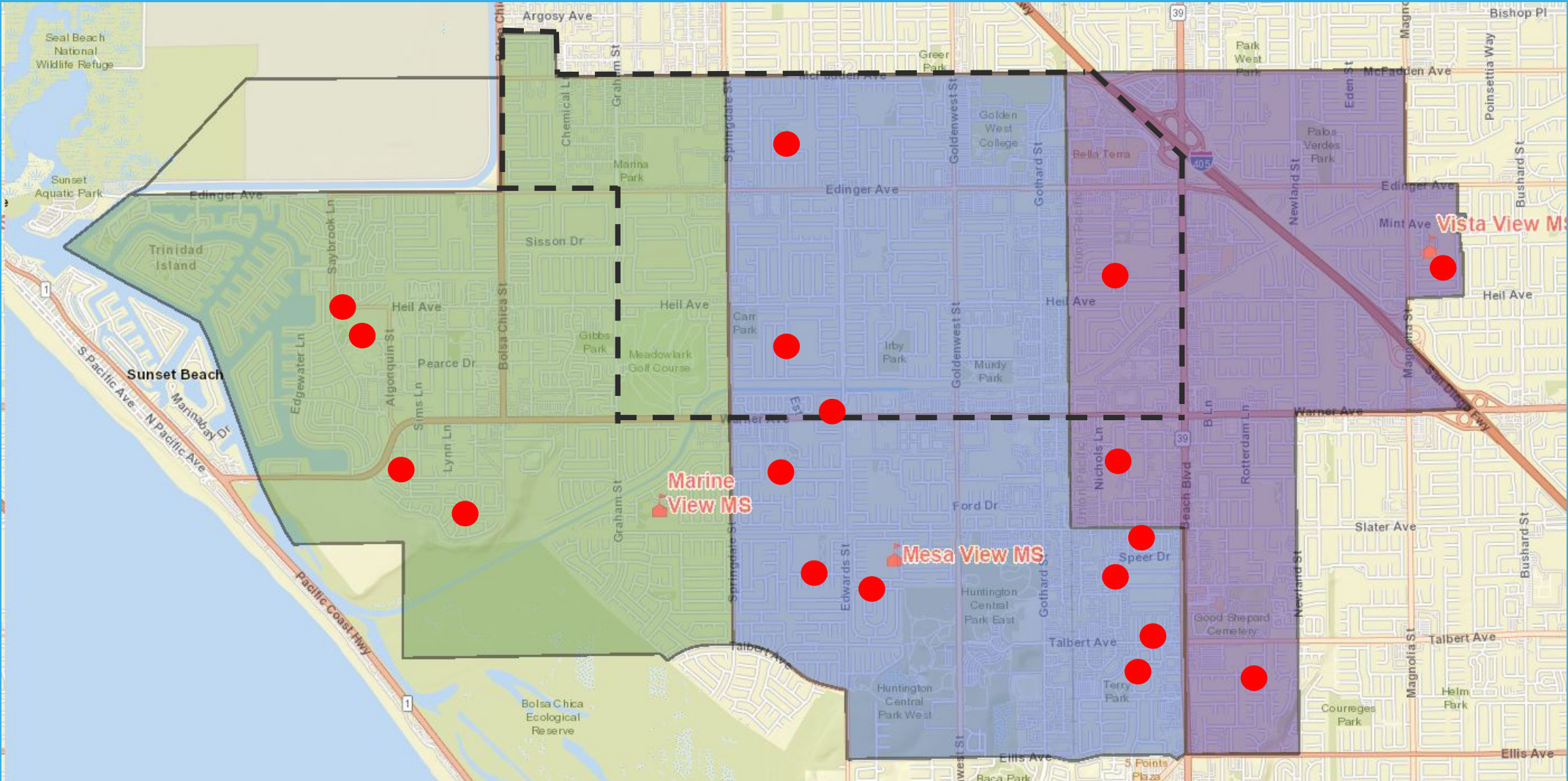


Revised Middle School Boundaries for Marine, Mesa, & Vista View Schools





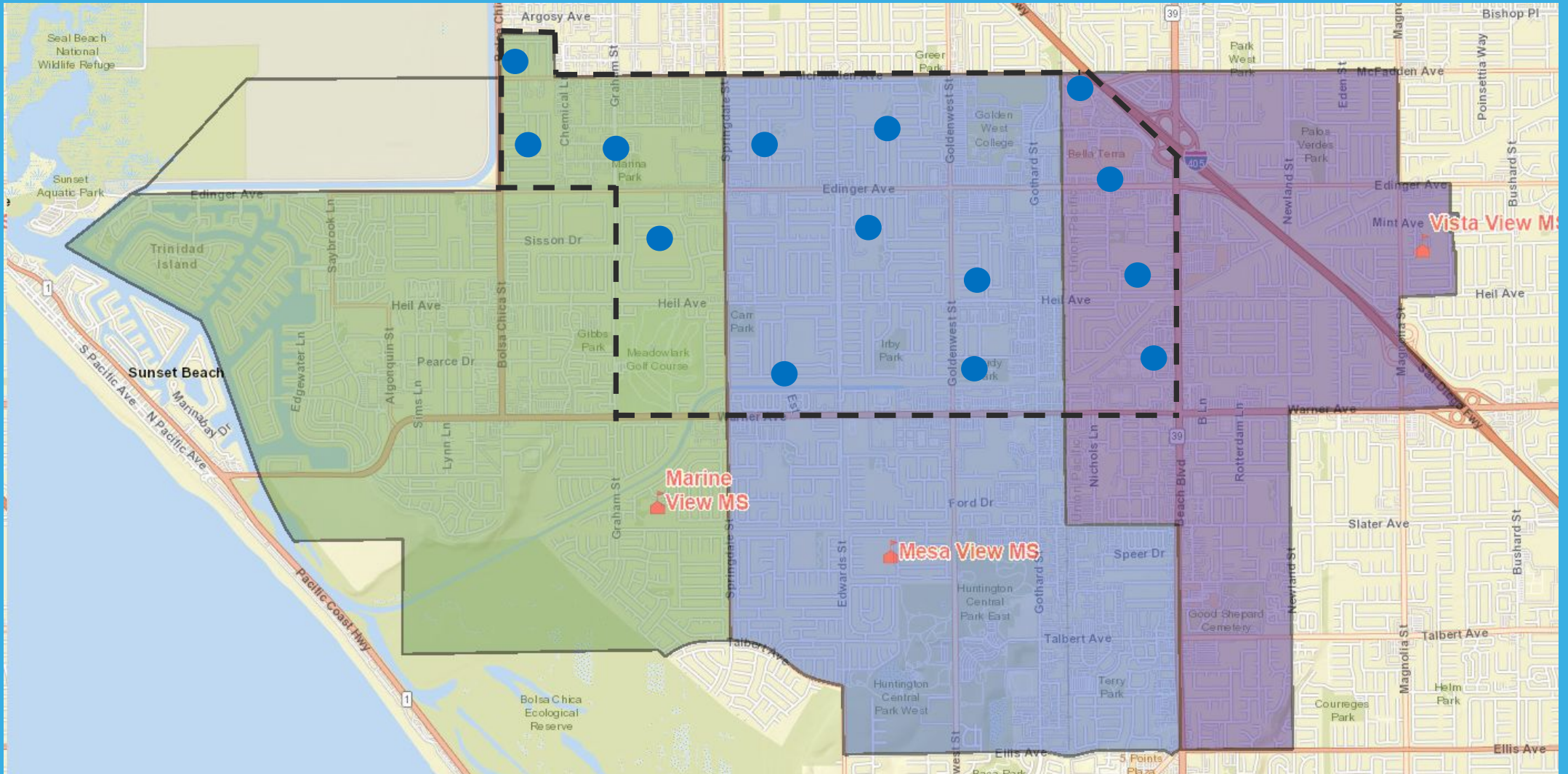
Stops are currently centralized and widely distributed, and walking distance and safety concerns are addressed in route planning



Note: Current general education bus stops for 2023-24



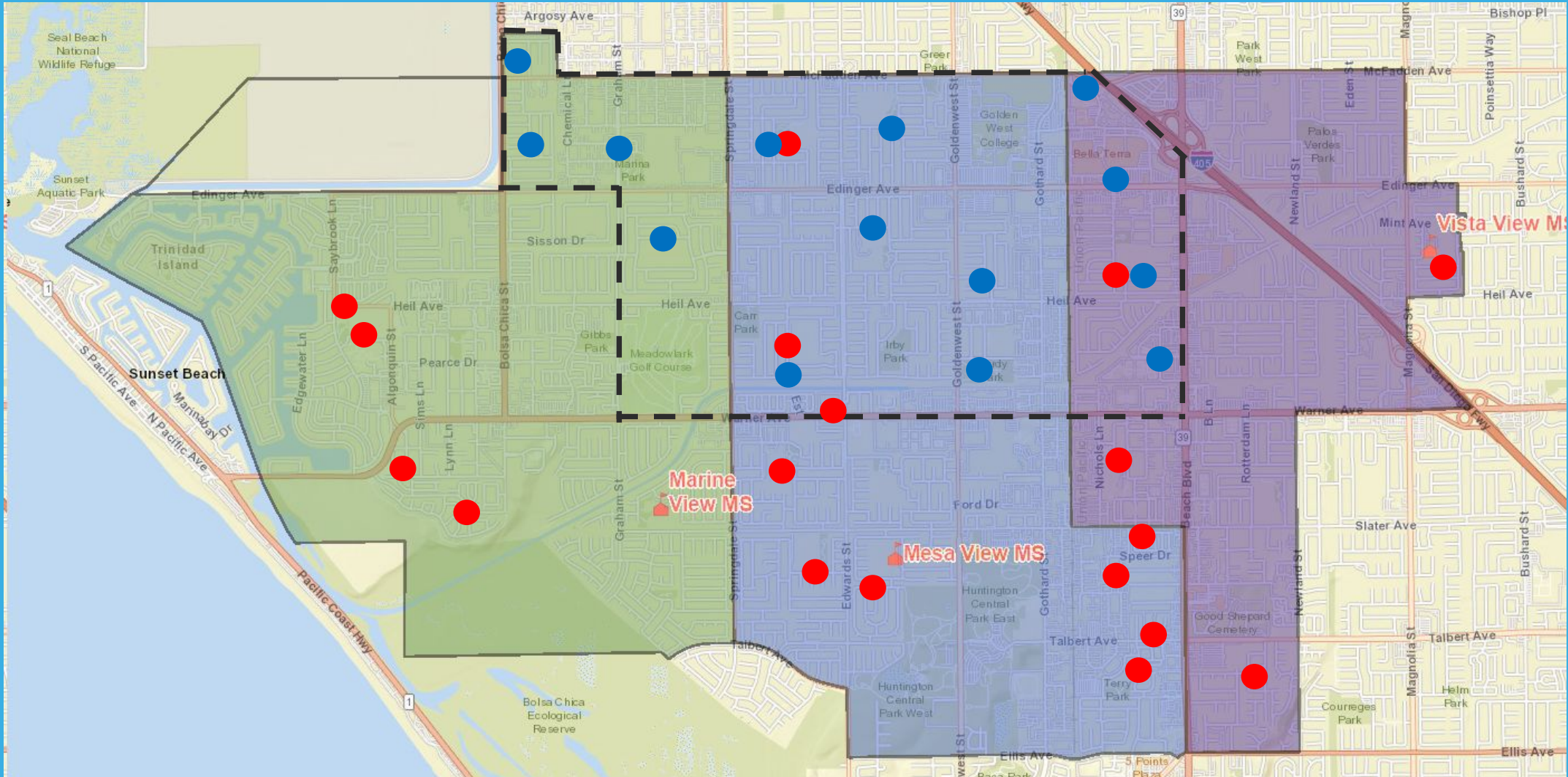
Who will be transported, and what will be the limitations, are there acceptable walking distances?

**State of CA Annual Requirement:
Home-to-School Transportation Plan
Board Approval on March 26, 2024**

CA ED Code Section 39800.1

(a) As a condition of receiving apportionments under Section 41850.1, a local educational agency shall develop a plan describing the transportation services it will offer . . . The plan shall be adopted by the local educational agency's governing board on or before April 1, 2023, and updated by April 1 each year thereafter.
