Student Schedules & Student Progress Center

Counselors are still working on schedules to ensure that all students have the correct classes required for graduation and to make sure that every student has a full schedule for the first day. **Students will receive schedules on their specific Smart Start day after the morning orientation in the gym.** Once school begins there will be a process for requesting a schedule change. Schedule change requests will take place the second week of school after all new students have been enrolled and scheduled.

Enrollment Numbers

As of today, John Ehret has an enrollment of 1911 students. The numbers are as follows:
Seniors = 367; Juniors = 502; Sophomores = 471; & Freshmen = 571

Directions for Parents to Log-In to the S.P.C.

Aside from their schedule, students/parents can check attendance, see up-to-the-minute averages and grades, see upcoming assignments, check for financial obligations, monitor discipline infractions, and see state test scores.

*Using the Parent Log-In, gives parents the opportunity to email teachers directly.

*Parents can use the “Communication” tab to make sure that contact information is up-to-date. If you are not receiving our text blasts or emails, you may to check this tab.

*You will NOT receive notifications for the boxes that you place a “check mark.”

4. Login on left side.

How to Find a Bus Number

Bus Drivers are to contact the students on their route.

If a student does not know their bus information, then it can be found online.

1. Go to the www.jpschools.org
2. On the homepage, scroll to the section “I Want to...”
3. Click on “Find my bus”
4. Once the page opens, “Select a grade” from the dropdown menu
5. Type in the House #.
6. Type in the Street.
7. Type in the Zip.
8. Click “Find School/Transportation Info”
9. A page will open up with the school, bus number, and the location/time of the bus pick-up.

2022-2023 Extenuating Circumstance Appeal Form for F* Grades (Germaine Gilson)

Families with students that experienced extenuating circumstances during the 22-23 school year and failed a course(s) due to excessive absences may make a formal appeal requesting an attendance requirement waiver. Parents/guardians must complete an appeal form and attach any supporting documentation. **Students have until August 28th to submit the paperwork to clear their F* grades!**

Students with an F* on their final report card may qualify for the waiver/appeal. The F* means the student failed the class due to absences only.

 The State of Louisiana, Department of Motor Vehicles requires all students to get a Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) card.

I. TO OBTAIN THE TEMPORARY INSTRUCTION PERMIT:
Parents must make an appointment to visit the Office of Motor Vehicles Students; go to www.expresslane.org, click: Book Appointment, then select the location nearest to you.

Requirements for Minor Students (15 – 17 years old and must be in the 8th grade or higher)

- Original or State Certified **Birth Certificate** (no photocopies)
- **Social Security Card**
- **Student's School ID**
- Legal Custodial/Domiciliary Parent/Guardian with their Driver's License or State ID Card
 - Guardians must have original or court-certified custody paperwork

Requirements for Adult Student (18 years or older)

- Original or State Certified Birth Certificate (no photocopies)
- Social Security Card
- Proof of residence (Two proof of residence if applying for a Real ID)

*Note: If an adult has a valid Louisiana State ID already issued and their Social Security Number is in the OMV's system, then only the ID and Proof of Residency are needed.

II. COST OF THE TEMPORARY INSTRUCTION PERMIT AT THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLES:
The Temporary Instruction Permit is \$32.25 with the possible service fee up to \$6.00. Forms of payment are Cash, Credit/Debit Card, Money Order and Check (check number must be over 1500 to be accepted) Convenience fees apply for Credit/Debit Cards and Check transactions.

When classes begin:

- Student is to bring the Temporary Instruction Permit to class.

When the student is participating in Behind the Wheel Training:

- TIP Card must be with the student.

Traffic Flow Before- and After School

Just as entering any major facility, John Ehret has specific traffic lanes before and after school.

When ENTERING campus:

- *Enter campus from the bridge on the right – closest to Barataria Blvd.
- *This bridge has two lanes of traffic (red and yellow)
- ***YELLOW** is for Buses. Buses travel to the back of campus to drop students off then return.
- ***RED** is for Parents & Student-Drivers.

Directly in front of school, there are two lanes of traffic.

- ***BLUE** is for parents dropping students off in front of school.
- ***RED** is for students driving to the "Student Parking" area or for parents dropping-off students.

When Exiting Campus:

- *The Exit Bridge is shown below on the left. It is the bridge furthest away from Barataria Blvd.
- *The Exit Bridge has 2 lanes.
- *Vehicles in the **GREEN** lane MUST TURN LEFT onto Patriot St (towards Barataria).
- *Vehicles in the **BLUE** lane have two options:
 - *Option 1: Turn RIGHT onto Patriot St (towards Destrehan Ave.) or
 - *Option 2: Go STRAIGHT down Avenue A towards the Westbank Expressway.



FREE LUNCH: Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Elected for Schools (Claire DeLerno)

JP Schools will be implementing a district-wide option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the *Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)* for School Year 2023-24. All enrolled students at John Ehret HS are eligible to receive a reimbursable breakfast and lunch meal **at no charge each day** for the 2023-24 school year. No further action is required of families, and students will be able to participate in the meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a meal application. Meals will remain available for adults and second student meals at a cost. Individual food items (i.e. milk, extra entrees & bread) may be purchased.
