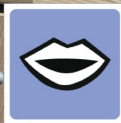
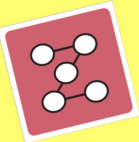
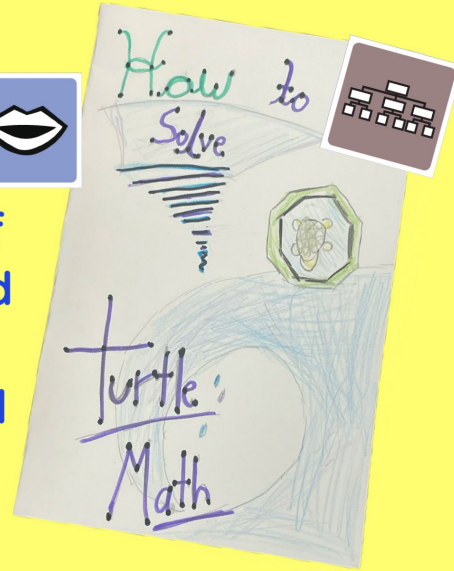


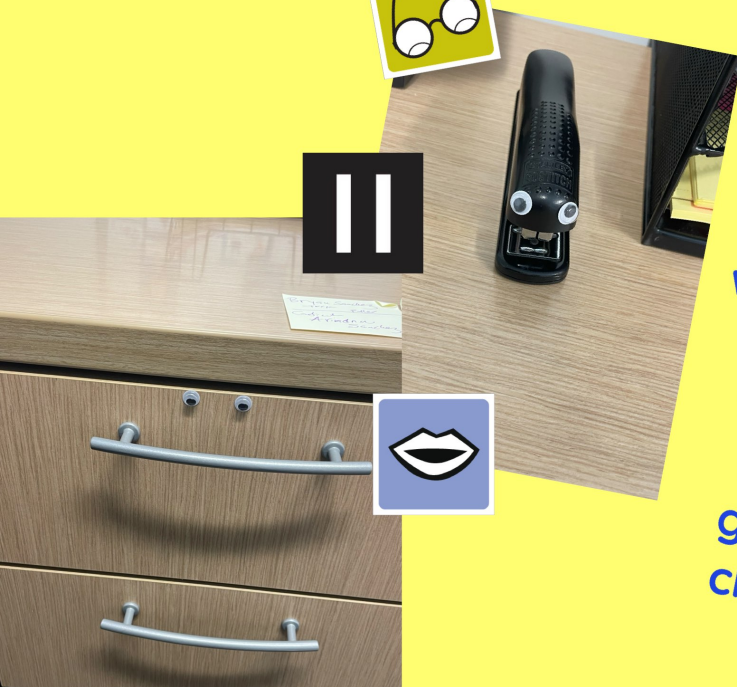
# SCHOLAR SPOTLIGHT
