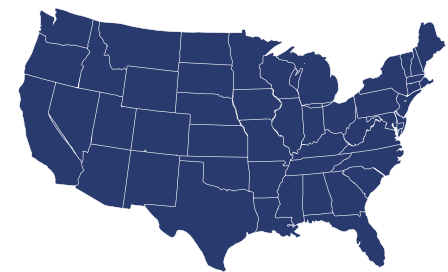
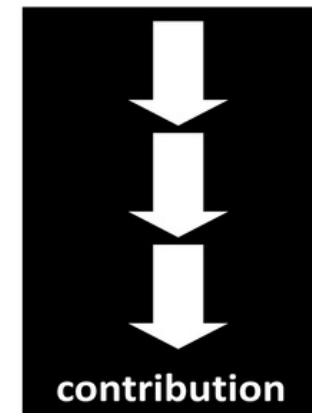


Scholar's Spotlight
