



RING CEREMONY

"The finger ring has always been a mark of distinction, prestige, and influence, worn with pride in every nation of the world. Seldom merely an article of adornment, rings usually have borne some significance - symbol of loyalty, love, or other affection - symbol of wealth and power - symbol of religion, patriotism, and influence, but always a mark of distinction. The class ring as we know it today originated in the year 1835 and was purchased by graduates of the United States Military Academy at Westpoint. It is generally believed that this was the first American school to use rings as a sign of recognition. The custom spread rapidly as a means of perpetuating the ideals and traditions of the school attended. Today the senior ring represents the most widely recognized custom in the world of education.

The symbolism of the many items on your ring, signifies the meaning of your school. On one side of your ring is the year of the schools founding, and on the other, the date of your graduation - both important, both memorable occasions.

Nestled in the shadow of the Huey Long bridge is the school itself, and beneath it a map of Louisiana with Riverdale's location starred. As an underlying background, Laurel leaves signify the wisdom and knowledge to which you have aspired in your school year. Symbolizing courage and facing the future, boldly glows the ruby stone – the final trademark of Riverdale High School."


