Parking Regulations 21-22

1. Driving to school is a privilege, which could be revoked at any time by the administration. The speed limit on campus is 10 mph. A student can reserve a certain spot for \$10. Students who do not want a certain spot can park on campus for free.
2. Parking permits are to be displayed on the rearview mirror.
3. Students are not permitted to park in the front parking lot.
4. Students should exit their vehicle and report to their designated areas upon arrival on campus.
5. All vehicles should be parked within the lines and locked. Students should only report back to their vehicles or the parking lot at their dismissal time unless given approval by the administration.
6. The school is not responsible for any items lost or stolen from vehicles.
7. Any vehicle parked on school property is subject to being searched by school officials.
8. Music should be kept at volume where only those inside the car can hear.
9. Students should pull forward into the parking spots. Parking in reverse causes carpool delays and accidents on rare occasions.
10. All documents such as a student's driver's license, proof of car insurance, and agreement of these rules must be submitted in order for students to park on-campus.

Any violation of the parking regulations can result in losing on-campus parking privileges.
