



ACPS Capacity Reassignment

Essential Point

- ACPS is supporting capacity reassigned students and families to return to their boundary school.



What is a capacity reassignment?

Policy JC-JCD and Regulation JC-R/JCD-R

Superintendent may place restrictions limiting assignment of elementary students to a particular grade level at a school based on capacity.

Superintendent and School Board review proposed class size caps and the number of homeroom sections for each school at each grade level during the budget process each Spring.

ACPS may reassign an elementary student to an alternate school in their capacity reassignment cluster where there is capacity at that grade level.

Transportation is provided per policy EEA.



Current Capacity Reassignment

- Of the students who are currently capacity reassigned, 72 students could move back into their boundary schools.
- Families have the option to return their student to the boundary school.

Benefits for Students

- Greater school engagement as students and families become part of community
- Less time traveling impacting overall social emotional development
- More effective use of ACPS resources



Next Steps

- Communication out to impacted students and families of the option to return to their boundary school during the week of June 19, 2023.
- Monitoring of 72 families' decision to return to boundary school and the impact on enrollment and transportation.
- Evaluate elementary capacity in the Fall and at the end of each school year to determine capacity for reassigned students to return.
