

OAK GROVE SCHOOL DISTRICT RESOLUTION NUMBER 1455-03/24

DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO PUBLIC CONTRACT CODE SECTIONS 22035 AND 22050

WHEREAS, Oak Grove School District ("District") suffered two (2) fallen trees damaging the roof and building façade that has impacted several classroom spaces at 500 Shawnee Lane, the previous Dickinson Elementary site currently leased to Challenger School, which displaced classroom operations for students and staff; and

WHEREAS, unless immediate action is taken to repair these damages as listed above, which has created adverse health and safety conditions; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that these repairs be undertaken immediately to allow Oak Grove School District staff to uphold the lease agreement with Challenger School so that their students may return to school in a safe and healthy environment; and

WHEREAS, under Public Contract Code Sections 22035 and 22050, in an emergency, in a district that has adopted the California Uniform Public Construction and Accounting Act, the governing body may proceed at once to replace or repair any public facility without adopting plans, specifications, strain sheets, or working details, or giving notice for bids to let contracts; and,

WHEREAS, Oak Grove School District has previously adopted the California Uniform Public Construction and Accounting Act; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board has determined, by at least a four-fifths vote herein recorded, that pursuant to Public Contract Code Sections 22035 and 22050, for the reasons set forth above, an emergency exists in that there is both a danger to life and/or property and that delay could interfere with resuming normal school operations; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon approval of this Resolution, the Board delegates to the Superintendent, or his designee, the authority to contract in writing with a reputable licensed contractor for the performance of the work required, such contract to be ratified by the Board; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon approval of this resolution, the Superintendent and/or the Board Designee shall have the authority to determine restoration and recovery measures that will be performed; and

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 14th day of March 2024 by the Governing Board of the Oak Grove School District at its regular meeting held at 6578 Santa Teresa Blvd., San Jose, CA 95119.


