# Our Title I - Goals

**Increase the index of seniors graduating with a basic or advanced credential from 75% to 78%**

**Increase the number of seniors eligible for a TOPS award from 17% to 20%**

**Increase the percentage of 11th & 12th grade students scoring silver or higher on workkeys from 52.8% to 56%**

**Decrease the % of students who are chronically absent (15 or more days a year) from 69.5% to 60%.**

**Increase the ELA overall percentage of 9th grade students scoring proficient from 22.6% to 25%**

**Increase the Math overall percentage of 9th grade students scoring proficient from 10.6% to 15%**

**Increase the ELA overall percentage of 10th grade students scoring proficient from 34.9% to 39%**

**Increase the Math overall percentage of 10th grade students scoring proficient from 29.1% to 33%**

# Our Title I - Goals

Increase the % of students scoring proficient on LEAP that are economically disadvantaged from 34 % to 38%

Increase the % of students scoring proficient on LEAP that are African American from 20% to 22%

Increase the % of students scoring proficient on LEAP in Biology from 15% to 19%.

Increase the % of students scoring proficient on LEAP in American History from 19.7% to 23%.
