Kindergarten Scientists at Work

The kindergartners just wrapped up their Human Body unit in science. They learned about different structures (organs) in the body and the jobs they do. Students used hands-on models to experience the ways muscles, bones, lungs, and the stomach function. The investigators conducted an experiment to simulate having fewer bones in the hands. They concluded that we really need all those bones! Finally, they were tasked with engineering a cast. It had to be strong, light, comfortable, and water resistant. They are one step closer to med school!








Second Grade News
