

## NOISE AND DUST MITIGATION STRATEGIES FROM BÆRUM KOMMUNE

As work on the Nadderud Stadium project begins in the upcoming weeks, OIS has been in ongoing dialogue with Bærum kommune regarding the construction impacts. This week, they shared a few key mitigation notes and strategies:

- 1. Impact on IB Diploma Programme Exams:** Students taking May 2024 IB Diploma Programme exams will not be impacted by noise from the project. Given that exams run through May 17, the kommune has agreed that any projects potentially causing noise will not be initiated until after that date to ensure a conducive environment for exam-takers.
- 2. Other Noise Notes:** In accordance with relevant regulations, the maximum noise level from the construction site throughout the project will be capped at 50 decibels.
- 3. Dust and Cleanliness:** To manage dust, the construction site will employ watering methods to bind dust particles and cover materials as necessary. Additionally, wheel washing stations will be installed for vehicles exiting the site to maintain cleanliness on adjacent roads. Road washing will also be conducted if required.
- 4. Compliance with Norwegian Regulations:** All aspects of the Nadderud Stadium project are being carried out in full compliance with the T-1442 Guidelines for the Treatment of Noise in Spatial Planning. These guidelines are integral to ensuring that the construction activities adhere to legal standards concerning environmental impacts.
