<p>New Business  Classified Handbook</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A draft of the Classified Handbook was presented for review and approval. This handbook contains information specific to classified employees and has been reviewed by classified directors and administration. A motion was made and passed to approve the Classified Handbook as presented. The handbook will be posted on the school website, and a link will be provided to classified staff to access it.</li> </ul>
<p><b>TAG Classification – Teachers/Stipends for Counselors &amp; SLPAs</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A motion was made and passed to approve the distribution of TAG stipends in the amount of \$542.78 (less TRF &amp; taxes) for teachers with a highly effective rating and \$434.22 (less TRF &amp; taxes) for teachers with an effective rating. As in the past, school counselors and SLPAs will also receive a stipend in these amounts which will be paid out of their regular salary line. <b>TAG stipends will be paid out on December 15<sup>th</sup>.</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Back-Pay – New Teacher Contracts</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Back-pay for the new teacher contracts will be paid out on December 8<sup>th</sup>.</b></li> </ul>
<p>Other</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At the last meeting, there was a question regarding our cameras and the capability of facial recognition. Officer Hough discovered the cameras do have the option of facial monitoring. A file can be loaded into the system, and the cameras will be constantly looking for that person’s face. The system can also scan for masks or firearms. An additional server would be needed for this. Mrs. Clouser-Penrod mentioned there are dollars in the Secured School Safety Grant that could help fund this. Officer Hough noted the system sends out an alert, email, and push notification when it picks up a face or mask, firearm, etc. So, notification can be received from anywhere. He will continue to look into this option and will bring the information for consideration.</li> </ul>
