

DUBLIN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT 2021 Survey Results

Methods

Data was gathered through a combination of secure SMS/text surveys and telephone interviews performed by specially-trained opinion research interviewers

Conducted with 460 randomly-selected voters registered in the Dublin City School District of Ohio, using a combination of valid residential, VOIP and cellular telephone listings

+/- 4.56% overall estimated margin of error, with a confidence interval of 9.12% within which the results can vary

September 13 – September 18, 2021

Data was stratified & weighted so that the differences in vital characteristics, such as age, gender and geography are represented in proportion to their percentages of the district's electorate

Due to rounding, not all results add up to 100%, and the data is presented in a different order than the questions were asked

Unless otherwise noted, only statisticallysignificant differences that were outside the confidence interval for the overall estimated margin of sampling error have been reported in this presentation of key findings


The survey was commissioned and funded by the Dublin City School District and the results are public information subject to disclosure under Ohio public records law






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


Change





During the time you have lived in the community, do you think it has generally changed a lot, somewhat or not at all?




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
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Housing Growth


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
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Impact of Housing







Generally speaking, would you say that the housing growth in the area has generally been good or bad for the community?

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



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Mood about Dublin CSD





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Social Media Exposure

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
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


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






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
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


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

* Differences are not statistically significant



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

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








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Class Sizes

* Differences are not statistically significant





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Facilities Concept Test

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Conclusion

Key Findings Recap

Residents of the community were cognizant of the growth that has occurred and appeared to be quite satisfied with it — even exuberant, perhaps — and did not appear to think that it has adversely affected the school system's ability to accommodate student enrollment

Although there was a marked change in the opinion climate, the mood surrounding the Dublin City School District was largely effusive, with few preponderant signs of disenchantment exhibited and, unlike many other school districts and public institutions, it has generally fared well in the free-wheeling sphere of social media

The benchmark performance ratings, such as for the quality of education and managing finances, were high and largely consistent with previous survey results, which is reassuring; teachers proved to be quite popular, suggesting that they can be persuasive advocates to promote the District and its objectives

As could be reasonably expected given the attunement to housing growth, there was acute awareness of the increase in enrollment, but few, including parents, bristled at the current class sizes

Only a narrow majority agreed that it was preferable to expand facility capacity, rather than endure the possible consequences, which suggests that more public education and information may be required before trying to seek a consensus on additional funding for building needs, with even those most sensitive to the effects of growth appearing to be somewhat apathetic
