ABC's About the Revised Budget

- The budget was reduced by \$1,083,448
- The proposed budget is at cap (1.22%) and will require 50% majority approval
- Eligible residents will receive rebate checks
- The Elementary Schools remain K-5

Realized savings:

- Changing health plan (NYSHIP) for all active & retiree staff
- Elimination 1 FTE in elementary
- Elimination 16 hours aide time per day
- Elimination clerical & grounds position through attrition

Budget Reductions \$1,083,448

Realized savings:

- Elimination varsity assistant coaches -
 - Except for: Spring Track (B) & (G), Swimming (B) & (G), one Football
- Elimination of secondary summer school
- Elimination of elementary curriculum leadership stipends

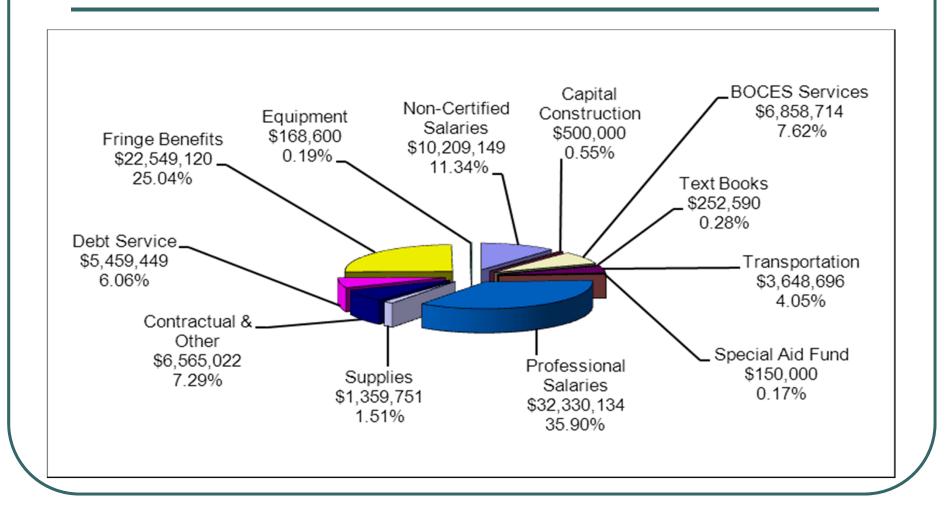

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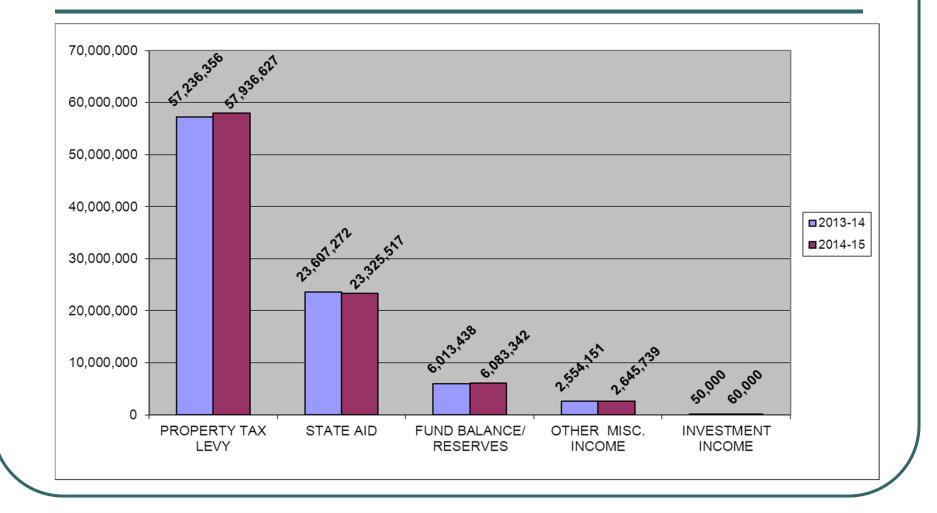
Revised Expenditures: The Pieces of the Pie (Re-vote 6/17/14)

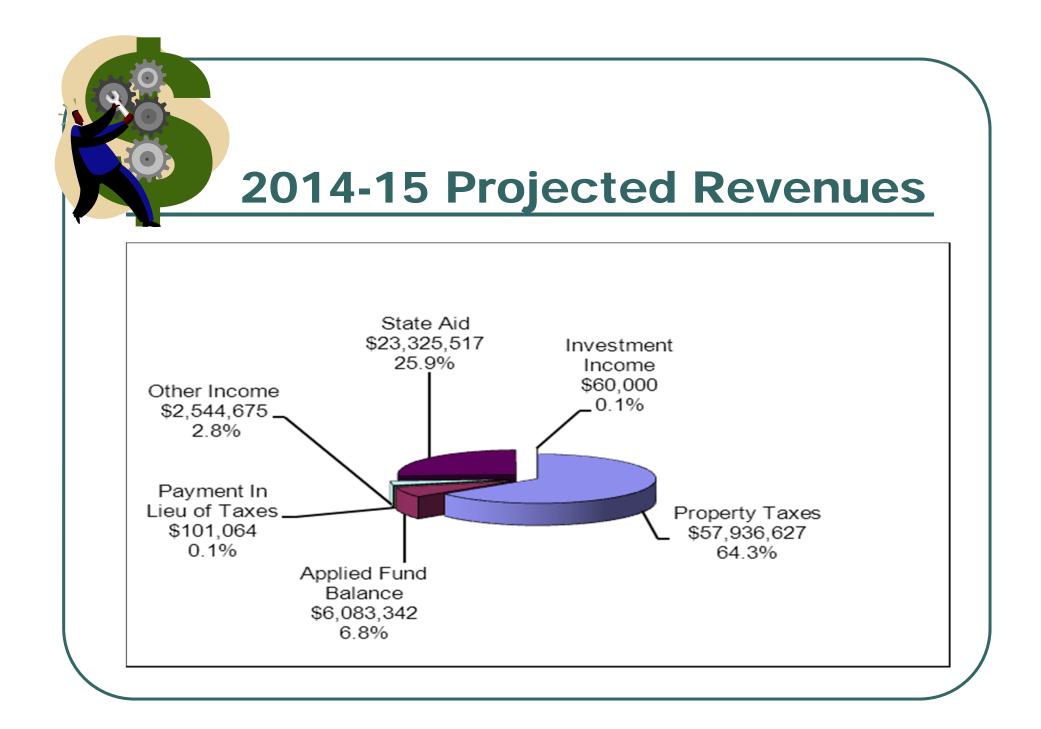


2014-15 Budgeted Revenues



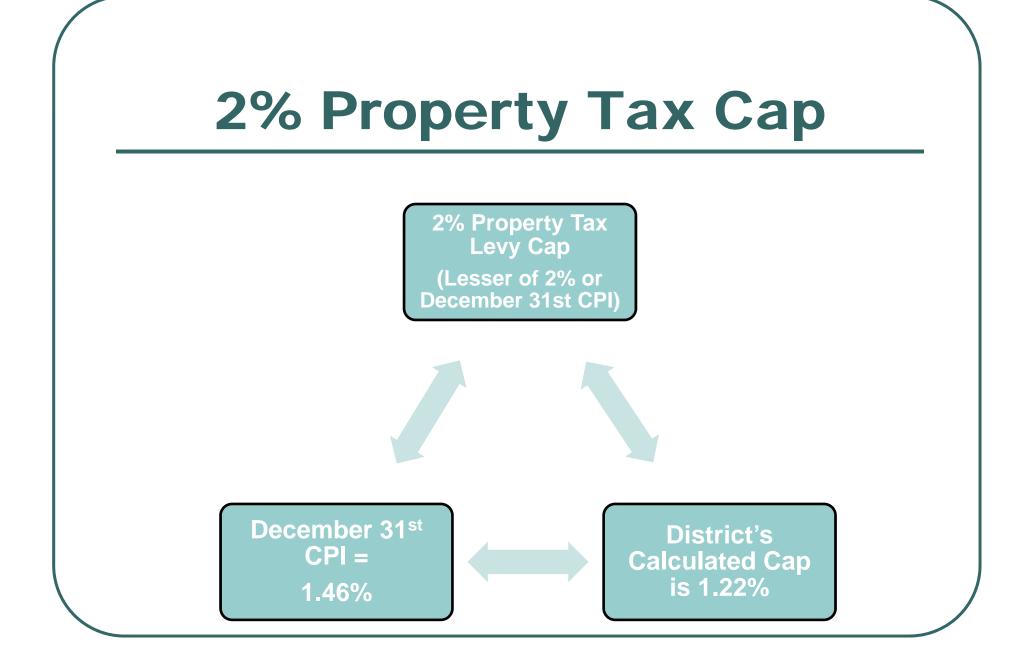
REVENUE COMPARISON Re-Vote 6/17/14

WE ARE AT THE TAX LEVY CAP

Property Tax Rebate Program

- The revised budget is under the Tax Levy Cap so you will receive a tax rebate check from NYS
- The projected annual tax increase for a home assessed at \$40,000 is \$90 (before STAR)



What will it mean for Sayville Schools?

Contingency Budget: Key Elements of the Law

 If the budget fails on June 17, 2014 the District must adopt a contingent budget with a '<u>ZERO</u>' percent increase on the current tax levy!

Contingency Budget

- Further budgetary reductions of \$1,334,992
- No voter approval permitted move right to contingency
- Contingency budget is a 0% increase on the prior year 'tax levy' – not tax rate

Contingency Budget: Consideration of the following:

- Re-districting of the three elementary schools:
 - K-1 Center, 2-3 Center, 4-5 Center
- Move to 8 Period Day at Middle School
 - Band, Orchestra & Chorus before or after school
 - Eliminate Studio Art Acceleration
 - Biology Lab before or after school
 - Eliminate: Current Issues, MST, Planetarium, Pathways for Success, Communication Skills, Computer Applications, Wellness and Computer Elective
- Move to 8 Period Day at High School
 - Reduction: 9 FTE of Electives & AP Courses will not run across disciplines
- Eliminate Middle School Sports
- Elimination of Administrative position & support staff
