The gifted program is offering a number of Q.U.E.S.T. activities for students in grades 1-5. This brochure describes the entire 2022-2023 school year's offerings. You may access it throughout the year on the gifted web page. Review the sessions in the online brochure, and then follow the registration and payment instructions below.

Registration Instructions:

Complete the online registration form for each selected class by **Thursday**, **August 22.** A link for each session form is directly below the class description. When a class fills up, it will be closed, and the registration form will be taken down. You should assume your child is enrolled in each session for which you were able to complete a form. If a class form is not accessible to you, that means the class is already full. If you are not able to register for a desired class and you would like your child's name added to a wait list, email Dawn Bowyer at <u>dbowyer@rcps.us</u>. Include the student's name along with the Q.U.E.S.T. session number and name.

Payment Instructions:

One payment for all classes should be sent to your child's school between **August 26 and September 9**. *Please do not send payment before August 26*. Cash cannot be accepted. Make payment electronically through <u>www.myschoolbucks.com</u> or by check payable to your child's school name & QUEST. (Registration for classes is not complete until payment is received.) Paper clip your check to the emergency information form and send to school.

Please print, complete and send with check to your child's school. If paying electronically, please send this form to your child's school **between August 26 and September 9**.

Session reminders:

For reminders, I will be using the app **remind.** You must join the remind system for each class your child is attending to receive text reminders. Instructions for joining are included at the end of the brochure of sessions offered. **Please record the class name, date, and time for your child's sessions on your own calendar in case our reminder system fails.**

Reimbursements:

If your child is not able to attend an activity for which he or she has been enrolled, please notify me, so a student on the wait list will have the opportunity to participate. **Reimbursements will not be made to those who register but do not attend a session.** Students will be reimbursed if a workshop is canceled by the gifted department.

Transportation:

Parents will provide transportation to and from each class. Please do not drop students off more than 10 minutes early. All students should be picked up from sessions on time. Teachers may have other commitments and need to be able to leave at the scheduled event time.

School Closures
