


ENGAGEMENT: STUDENTS

Average Percent of Constituents Who Feel [Children Are] Engaged in/Enjoy Learning in School






ENGAGEMENT AND ENJOYMENT: TEACHERS

Average Percent of Constituents Who Believe Child/Self/Students are Independent & Responsible Learners






HOMEWORK & ASSESSMENTS





Occurence of Themes During Elementary Faculty/Staff Focus Group Conversations





FOCUS GROUP FEEDBACK: LITERACY

- Teachers communicated difficulties and inconsistencies with the implementation and pacing of the K-5 literacy curriculum.
- Teachers expressed the need to evaluate and clarify the set of approaches used to provide reading and writing instruction.



FOCUS GROUP FEEDBACK: MATH

- Teachers expressed concerns over the scope and pacing of the K-5 math curriculum.
- Additional professional development and targeted support will improve implementation of math curriculum.



FOCUS GROUP FEEDBACK: SCIENCE

- Recently implemented NYS Science Standards require a shift in instruction.
- Professional development will equip teachers with the tools to ensure students meet expectations.


FOCUS GROUP FEEDBACK: ACADEMIC INTERVENTION & SUPPORT

- Teachers expressed the desire to better utilize AIS specialists:
 - "They have so much information they could be sharing with us, but their schedules are packed and they can't even see all of the kids who need help."
- AIS specialists have already been added to provide additional support.
- Students who struggle but do not qualify from Special Education Services could benefit from enhanced AIS support.
- Committee will formalize clear and consistent plan across buildings.




Average Percent of Constituents Who Feel They/Their Children are Cared For, Respected, & Accepted


Average Percent of Constituents Who Feel Emotionally Safe in School






STUDENTS' EMOTIONAL SAFETY, DISAGGREGATED

Average Percent of Secondary Students who Feel Emotionally Safe in School, by Race/Ethnicity Group








Average Percent of Constituents Who Feel Sayville School Buildings are Clean and Well-Maintained








COMMUNICATION: TEACHERS

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


- Focus Group remarks showed both appreciation for teacher communication and desire for more, particularly at secondary level.
