

What we will be learning: Most students should be able to:

- Addition and subtraction fact fluency
 Paragraph with proper capitalization and punctuation.
 (narrative, informational, & opinion)
- Solves number stories with addition, subtraction, and missing addends
- ★ Partition shapes into equal parts★ Tell time to the hour & half hour
- Read a variety of books independently with fluency, expression
- Retell a story with main events, character, setting, main idea, and central message
- Can count a collection of pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters up to .99 cents
- ★ Have a basic understanding of non-standard measurement
- Understands place value



1. Get a head start:

Introduce some of the curriculum to your child over the summer:

- * Reading
- * Addition/Subtraction
- * Coin identification & Value
- ★ Discuss books (character, setting)



2. Read, read, and read:

- ★ Repeated reading★ Story elements
- ★ Vocabulary (discuss word meaning)★ Sight words





3. Encourage Trying:

- ★ Encourage independence
 ★ learning from mistakes
 ★ "You can do it" approach

 - * Growth Mindset "I just can't do it yet"







4. Send them off on the right foot:

- * Good, nutritious breakfast and lunch
- ★ Healthy amount of sleep
 ★ Backpack prepared: take-home folder, library books, lunch, etc.



5. Be involved:

- * Communicate with the teacher
- ★ Look through your child's backpack/red folder
- * Ask your child what they are currently learning
- * Checkout Seesaw posts daily



Attendance:

Studies show...



- ★ Developing a habit of good attendance will help your child do well in school, college and work
- * Attendance matters in every grade
- ★ Though some absences are unavoidable, too many can affect student success, whether the absences are excused or unexcused
- ★ Setting a regular bedtime and morning routine will help with being on time to school
- * Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school and themselves!
