2 Adult Education

- 3 1. The Adult Education Department is part of the Great Falls Public Schools. This department offers  
4 post-high-school courses and high school credit classes for out-of-school adults. The basic intent  
5 of the Adult Education Department is to offer courses that are of an educational nature on the  
6 premise that learning is a lifelong endeavor. Classes are offered which are focused on high school  
7 equivalency (G.E.D.), adult basic education (ABE), adult skill and interest areas, and in vocational  
8 and non-vocational areas, providing that suitable space and qualified instructors are available and  
9 that sufficient interest justifies the class.
- 10 2. Fee for various classes will be recommended by the Executive Director for Business upon  
11 consultation with the Alternative Education Principal who also acts as Director of Adult Education,  
12 and will be determined in relation in the cost, number of adults served, and reimbursement.
- 13 3. In addition to the above, the Adult Education Department is charged with the responsibility of  
14 supervision and administration of the various federal programs for adults, within guidelines of the  
15 programs and the Great Falls Federal Programs Office.
