

5 Contact with Students

7 Students are entrusted to the schools for educational purposes. Although educational purposes
8 encompass a broad range of experiences, school officials must not assume license to allow
9 unapproved contact with students by persons who are not employed by the District for
10 educational purposes.

12 Teachers may arrange guest speakers on appropriate topics relative to the curriculum. Principals
13 may approve school assemblies on specific educational topics of interests and relevance to the
14 school program. Other types of contact by non-school personnel will normally not be permitted.

16 Unless authorized by the building administrator or otherwise required by District policy or state
17 and federal law, the District will not allow access to the schools by outside individuals, entities,
18 businesses, service providers, or outside organizations desiring to use the captive audience in a
19 school for information, sales, material, or special interest purposes or delivery of services to
20 students or groups of students that are unrelated to District operations.
