48	PROPOSITION ELEMENTARY GENERAL FUND Shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to impose an increase in local taxes to support the Elementary General Fund in the amount of One million, seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$ 1,750,000) per year which is approximately 12.05 mills, for the purpose of: The Operation and Maintenance of the educational programs. Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$ 16.27 per year and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$ 32.54 per year. The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the District levies that amount at least once in the next five years.
