Title I Parental and Family Engagement

School Responsibilities:

- Create a welcoming and positive learning environment for students and parents.
- Involve parents in planning, reviewing, and improving the school's Title I Site Plan and Schoolwide Improvement plan.
- Hold an annual meeting to inform parents of the school's participation in Title I and family engagement opportunities

- Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's academic and behavioral progress. In each classroom we will provide progress reports through Parent/Teacher conferences, samples of student work, updates on reading, nightly agenda logs, writing and math assessments. Wednesday folders will be sent home. We will initiate a parent contact at the first signs of a pattern of behavior (behaviorally or academically) that interferes with student learning.
- Provide a digital student handbook for all families to view on the school website.
- Teach, reinforce, model, and encourage the school PBIS expectations: Leaders are respectful, responsible, prepared learners.

Parent and Family Responsibilities

- Make sure that my child is on time and strives for 100 percent attendance, and contact the school if my child is absent.
- Establish a time and place for homework and work with my child to return it on the appropriate due date to their teacher.
- Monitor the amount of television/video games my child watches/plays and ensure that my child gets enough sleep each night.
- Participate in conferences and family nights, look at school work, and call the school as needed.
- Check with my child daily for information sent home from school and Wednesday folder, read it and respond, if necessary.
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my child's education.
- Encourage your child to read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school time.
- Read the student handbook with your child.
- Encourage your child to follow the PBIS expectations: Leaders are respectful, responsible, prepared learners.

Student Responsibilities

- Come to school each day ready to learn and do my best.
- Read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school time.
- Give my parents (or the adult who is responsible for me) all papers, agenda, Wednesday folder, and information sent home with me from the school.
- Complete my class work/homework and ask for help when I don't understand.
- Follow our PBIS expectations: Leaders are respectful, responsible, prepared learners.
