



2024 Distinguished Service Award

With the mission of the Midland Public Schools serving as its focus, the Board of Education acknowledges the valuable contributions made by its support staff in providing an excellent education for our students. A quality educational system can only occur when every employee group works together to promote the welfare of the students and the community it serves.

To further recognize the effort put forth by members of our support staff, the Midland Public Schools' Board of Education has established the "Distinguished Service Award" to be presented annually.

ELIGIBILITY:

Full-time and part-time (non-certificated) employees in the following groups are eligible for nomination:

- ◇ **Administrative Assistants** ◇ **Managers /Directors** ◇ **Paraprofessionals** ◇ **Transportation**
- ◇ **Grounds & Maintenance** ◇ **Office Professionals** ◇ **Technicians**

(Teachers/Administrators are not eligible for this award)

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

The person that is nominated:

- ◆ Must have been employed for at least three years.
- ◆ Must not be retiring the year nominated.
- ◆ Must perform above job expectations/requirements.

PROCEDURES FOR SELECTION:

- ◆ Nomination window is now OPEN!
- ◆ Nominations may be received via the on-line form or by letter.
- ◆ Nominations must be **received by Friday, May 24, 2024.**

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Selection Committee shall establish procedures for processing nominations and the criteria for determining who is selected. The committee shall be comprised of:

- ◆ One elementary administrator;
- ◆ One secondary administrator;
- ◆ One MPS parent;
- ◆ One Board of Education member; and
- ◆ The previous year award recipients.

Appointments shall be made by the Superintendent

AWARDS:

The awards will be presented at the beginning of the 2024-25 school year.

- ◆ Up to four individuals may be selected each year.
- ◆ Each recipient shall receive a stipend and a gift commemorating their award.
