


Emergency Medical Technician Program (EMT)

Looking for an exciting career in Emergency Medical Services or a course that is a great stepping stone in the medical field? This 172-hour course is designed to prepare you for National and State Certification. Train to be job ready and learn the skills necessary to identify, treat and transport patients with routine or life-threatening injuries. Students will participate in clinical rotations in the Hospital and EMS settings. Fee covers tuition, books, uniform shirt, BLS/CPR course and mandatory background check.

Clinical Medical Assistant w/Optional Externship (online available)

This program is intended for students who want to prepare for an exciting, challenging and rewarding career in healthcare. Students learn to assist physicians by performing functions related to the clinical responsibilities of a medical office. Instruction includes, among other things, preparing patients for examination and treatment, routine laboratory procedures, diagnostic testing, technical aspects of phlebotomy and the cardiac life cycle. Students will review important topics including phlebotomy, pharmacology, the proper use and administration of medications, taking and documenting vital signs, cardiology including proper lead placements, professional workplace behavior, ethics and the legal aspects of healthcare. This program includes classroom lecture, hands on labs and an optional externship opportunity at a local healthcare provider.

<u>National Certification</u>: After the successful completion of this program, students will be prepared to sit for the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) Exam as well as the National Workforce Career Association (NWCA) Clinical Medical Assistant (CMAC) Exam.

Home Health Aide (IN-PERSON ONLY)

Home Healthcare Aides assist patients in their homes by focusing on their specific health and personal needs. Emphasis is on giving personal care in a client's home, communications, working with ill persons, basic human needs, eldercare, nutrition, special diets, and home management. Home Healthcare Aides also work in hospitals, clinics, rehabilitation centers, home care, long term care facilities, hospice and assisted living facilities. Detailed course topics and review include: the role of the home health aide, client relationships, infection control, hospice care, anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, dressing and personal grooming, foot care, nutrition and other relevant topics.

EKG Technician Certification Program (online available)

This comprehensive 50-hour EKG Technician Certification Program prepares students to function as EKG Technicians and to take the NWCA - Electrocardiograph (EKG) Technician exam and other National Certification Exams. This course will include important practice and background information on anatomy and physiology of the heart, medical disease processes, medical terminology, medical ethics, legal aspects of patient contact, electrocardiography and stress testing. Additionally, students will practice with EKG equipment and perform hands-on labs including introduction to the function and proper use of the EKG machine, the normal anatomy of the chest wall for proper lead placement, 12-lead placement and other clinical practices. In-Classroom price includes \$100 National Exam Fee. National Certification: After the successful completion of this program, students will be prepared to sit for the National Workforce Career Association (NWCA) Certified EKG Technician (CET) exam. This exam will be given as part of the in-person class.

Pharmacy Technician Program w/Optional Externship (online available) This comprehensive 50-hour program will prepare students to work as a Pharmacy Technician in a retail or other pharmacy setting and to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board's PTCB exam. Course content includes: pharmacy medical terminology, the history of pharmacy, pharmacy practice in multiple environments, pharmacy calculations and measurements, reading and interpreting prescriptions and defining drugs by generic and brand names. Through classroom lecture and hands-on labs (classroom format only), students will review dosage calculations, drug classifications, the "top 200 drugs", I.V. flow rates, sterile compounding, dose conversions, aseptic technique, the handling of sterile products, total parenteral nutrition (TPN), dispensing of prescriptions, inventory control and billing

<u>National Certification</u>: This program meets the necessary requirements to take the Pharmacy Technician Certified Board (PTCB) - Certified Pharmacy Technician (PTCB) exam.

reimbursement.

Medical Billing and Coding Program (ONLINE ONLY)

This combined 80-hour billing and coding course offers the skills needed to solve insurance billing problems, how to manually file claims (using the CPT and ICD-10 manual), complete common insurance forms, trace delinquent claims, appeal denied claims and use generic forms to streamline billing procedures. The course covers the following areas: CPT

(Introduction, Guidelines, Evaluation and Management), specialty fields (such as surgery, radiology and laboratory), ICD-10 (Introduction and Guidelines) and basic claims processes for medical insurance and third party reimbursements. Students will learn how to find the service and codes using manuals, (CPT, ICD-10 and HCPCS).

National Certification: After obtaining the practical work experience (6 months to 2 years), students who complete this course could be qualified to sit for the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC) - Certified Professional Coder Exam (CPC); or Certified Outpatient Coder Exam (COC); the American Health Information Association (AHIMA) Certified Coding Associate (CCA) exam; and/or other National Certification Exams.
