Year-round medication disposal is available the Sheriff's Annex behind the Roanoke County Juvenile Relations building at the corner of E. Calhoun Street and Strawberry Lane.

No appointment is necessary - the public is welcome.

Simply bring your medications (**no needles please**) to this event where they can be safely collected and destroyed by local law enforcement and DEA agents.

- Lock up or hide your medications to prevent others from taking them.
- Don't flush your medications - trace amounts of the chemicals in medications can end up in our nation's waterways.
- Dispose of your medications at secure take-back sites.
