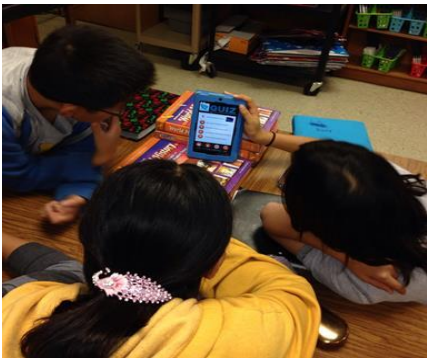

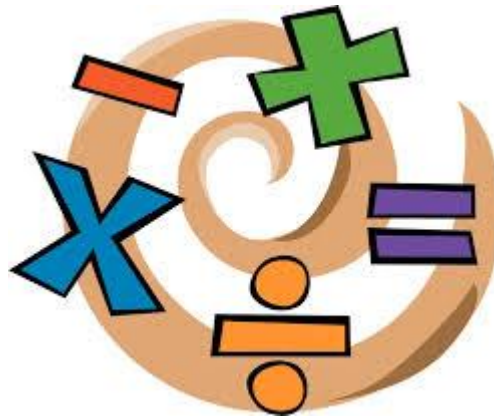

Grading

6 Week Grading Periods/2 Semester Grades

Grading Period 1: Weeks 1-6 = Progress Report of Grades

Grading Period 2: Weeks 7-12 = Progress Report of Grades

Grading Period 3: Weeks 13-18 = Semester 1 Grades (final Fall transcript grade)

Grading Period 4: Weeks 19-24 = Progress Report of Grades

Grading Period 5: Weeks 25-30 = Progress Report of Grades

Grading Period 6: Weeks 31-36 = Semester 2 Grades (final Spring transcript grade)

Citizenship Grades

- Reported every 6 weeks on progress report (not factored in as part of GPA)
- Office referrals and suspensions affect citizenship grade
 - A = no referrals/suspensions
 - B = up to 2 office referrals
 - C = 1 suspension or up to 4 office referrals
 - D = up to 6 office referrals OR 1 suspension and up to 2 referrals
 - F = 2 suspensions OR 1 suspension and up to 3 referrals OR more than 6 referrals
- Citizenship grade impacts eligibility for school events (field trips, assemblies, watching after school sports, dances, etc.) and sports teams eligibility
- 4 tardies in one period per month = Automatic Office Referral

Middle School Awards

End of 1st Semester = Honor Society/Honor Roll Awards

Honor Society Award = 1st Semester GPA 4.0

Honor Society Award = 1st Semester GPA 3.99-3.5

Mustang Award = 1st Semester GPA 3.49 - 3.0

End of 5th Grading Period = MS Awards Event

**cumulative GPA 1st-5th grading periods*

4.0 (certificate of achievement and medal)

3.99 - 3.83 (certificate of achievement and pin)

3.82-3.5 (certificate of achievement)

3.49-3.0 (certificate of recognition)

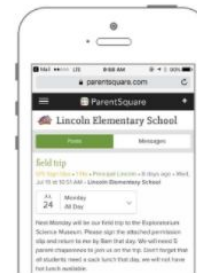
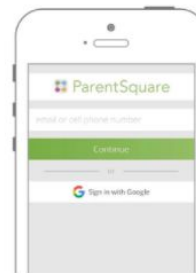
